Part 1 - Social Issue

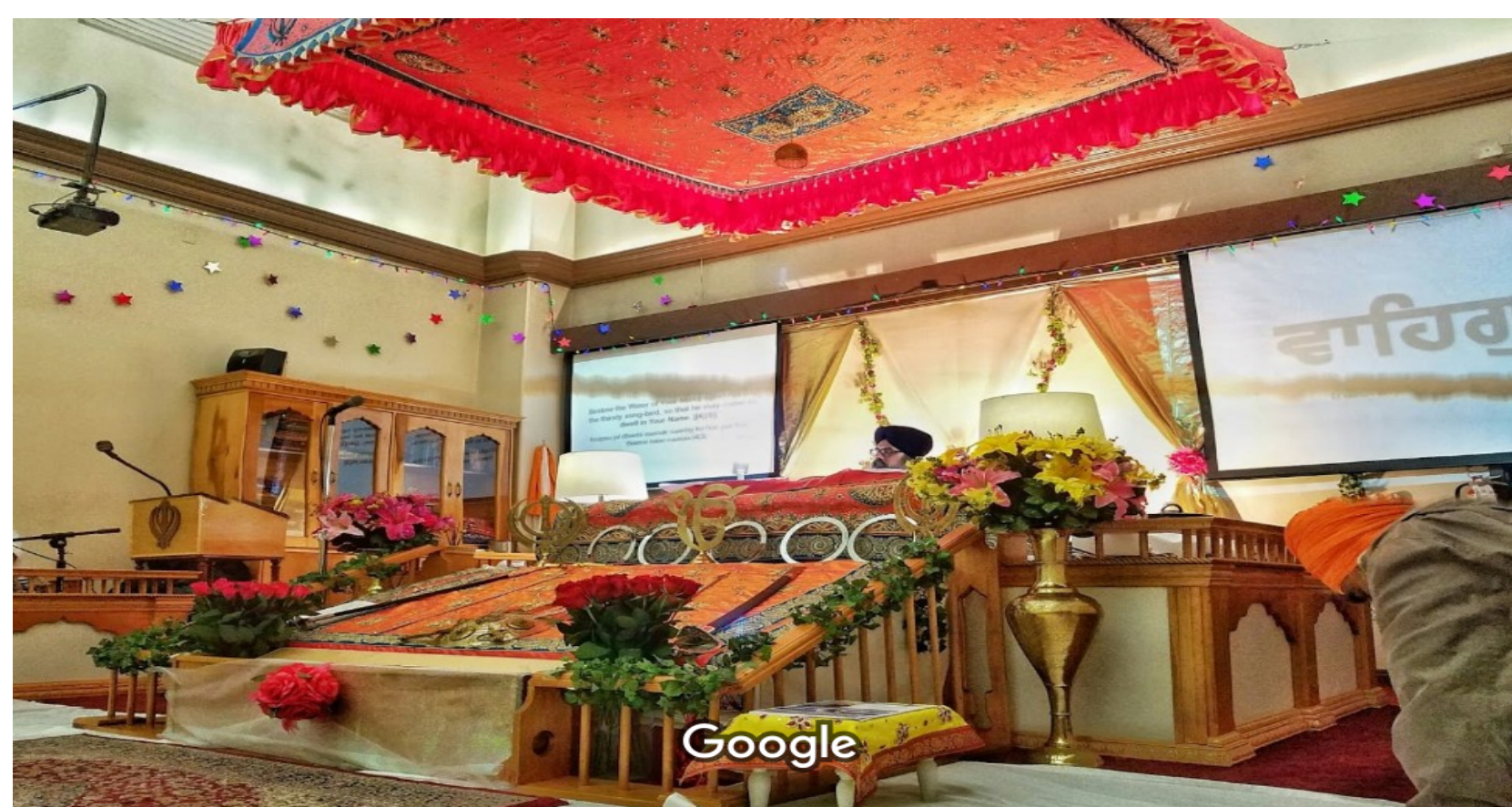
Hunger and starvation is a huge problem around the world.
