2021 SALARY SCORES: UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA, LAS VEGAS AND UNIVERSITY OF NEVADA, RENO

PURPOSE:

This fact sheet provides a comparative analysis on salary earnings for graduates of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) and the University of Nevada, Reno (UNR). Data are gathered from the *GradReports* website, which offers salary scores ranging from 0 to 100 for UNLV and UNR degree programs.

ABOUT THE DATA:

GradReports allows users to compare employment and salary rankings for over 2,281 schools and 885 college degree types across the nation.² This fact sheet explores the employment rate, median salary, and salary score values for UNLV³ and UNR programs.⁴ Each college in the GradReports database receives its own webpage that displays the employment rate, median debt, median salary, and salary score values for individuals with bachelor's, master's, and doctoral degrees. The comparative analysis groups each area of study by level of education and field of study. Salary scores range from 0 to 100 and are calculated by comparing program-specific median alumni earnings to median alumni earnings for the same field of study across all colleges that provide data. A salary score closer to 0 means that the program has much lower median alumni earnings in comparison to other schools offering a degree in the same field of study. Likewise, a salary score closer to 100 means that the program has much higher median alumni earnings in comparison to other schools offering a degree in the same field of study.

In this fact sheet, data for UNLV and UNR are organized by level of postgraduate degree (bachelor's, master's, and doctoral) and field of study.

KEY FINDINGS:

- 1. UNLV reports 45 bachelor's degree programs, 19 master's degree programs, and 6 doctoral degree programs.
- 2. UNR reports 51 bachelor's degree programs, 18 master's degree programs, and 3 doctoral degree programs.
- 3. For both UNLV (100) and UNR (98), Social Work is the bachelor's degree with the highest salary score.
- 4. For UNLV (15), International Business is the bachelor's degree with the lowest salary score; for UNR (0), Chemical Engineering is the bachelor's degree with the lowest salary score.
- 5. Among bachelor's degrees, the highest median salaries are in Registered Nursing, Nursing Administration, Nursing Research and Clinical Nursing at both UNLV (\$75,810) and UNR (\$69,950).
- 6. At UNLV (99), the Hospitality Administration/Management master's degree has the highest salary score. At UNR (98), the General Psychology master's degree has the highest salary score.
- 7. UNLV's Rehabilitation and Therapeutic Professions doctoral degree received a perfect salary score of 100.

Table 1 shows employment rate and salary metrics for bachelor's degrees by field of study at UNLV and UNR. Cells without a numerical value (--) indicate that the university does not report data for that field of study. UNLV has 7 bachelor's programs with an employment rate of 100% out of 45 total programs listed, and UNR has 8 bachelor's programs with an employment rate of 100% out of 51 total programs listed. The highest-paying bachelor's programs are UNLV's Registered Nursing, Nursing Administration, and Clinical Nursing degree (\$75,810 median salary) and UNR's Mining and Mineral Engineering degree (\$75,520 median salary). UNLV's Social Work degree has the highest salary score (100), and UNR's Chemical Engineering program has the lowest salary score (0).

Table 2 shows employment rate and salary metrics for master's degrees by field of study at UNLV and UNR. Cells without a numerical value (--) indicate that the university does not report data for that field of study. UNLV has 9 master's programs with an employment rate of 100% out of 19 total programs listed, and UNR has 14 master's programs with an employment rate of 100% out of 18 total programs listed. The nursing degrees at both UNR (\$109,920 median salary) and UNLV (\$106,420 median salary), as well as UNLV's Business Administration degree (\$93,820 median salary) are the highest-paying fields of study. UNLV's Hospitality Administration/Management degree has the highest salary score (99), and UNR's Biotechnology degree has the lowest salary score (9).

Table 3 shows employment rate and salary metrics for doctoral degrees by field of study at UNLV and UNR. Cells without a numerical value (-) indicate that the university does not report data for that field of study. All of UNR's doctoral programs have an employment rate of 100%; UNLV's Registered Nursing, Nursing Administration, Nursing Research and Clinical Nursing doctoral degree also has an employment rate of 100%. UNLV's Dentistry degree (\$125,020 median salary) and Registered Nursing, Nursing Administration, Nursing Research and Clinical Nursing degree (\$122,040 median salary) are the highest-paying fields of study. UNLV's Rehabilitation and Therapeutic Professions degree has the highest salary score (100), and UNR's Psychology degree has the lowest salary score (9).
