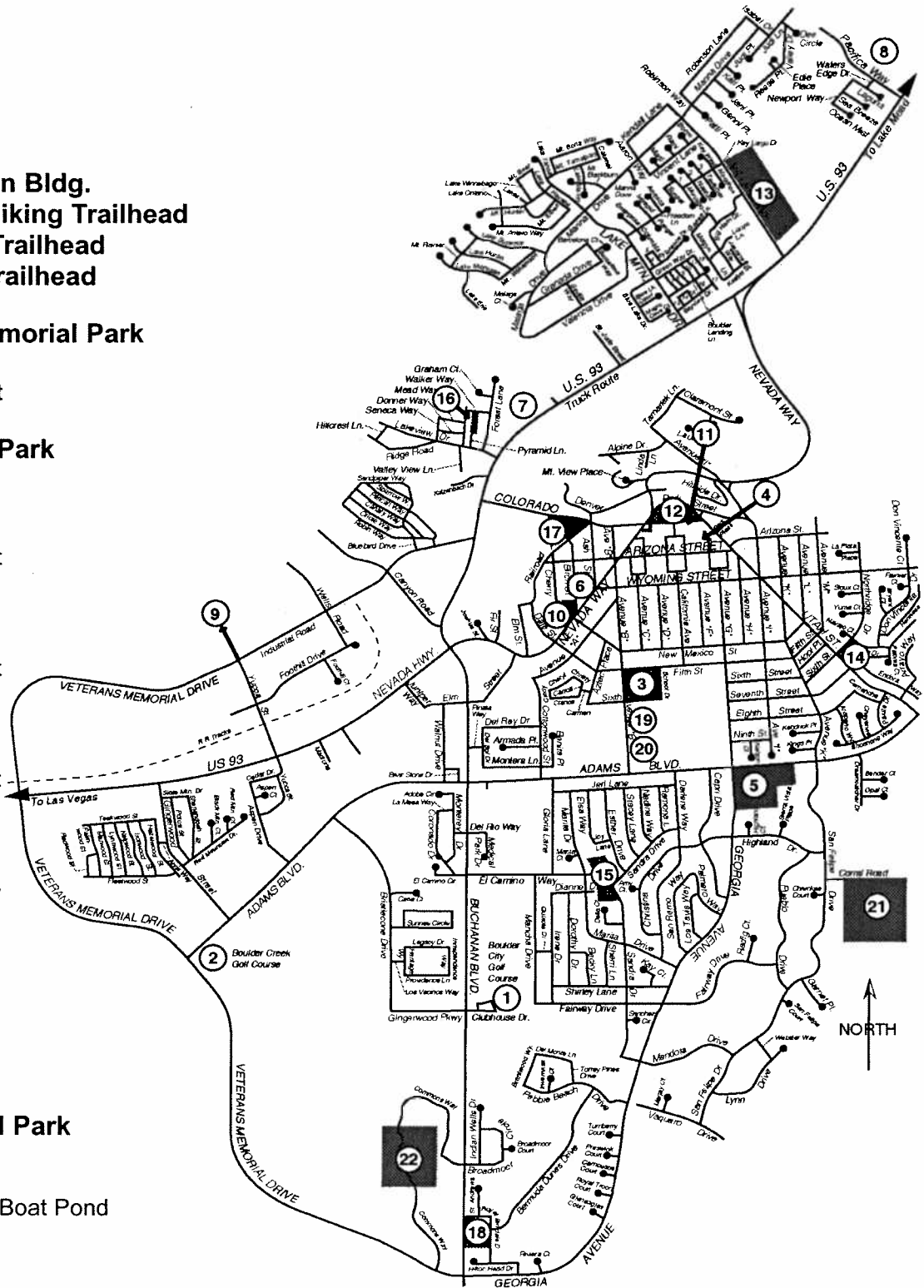

5 ADAMS BLVD COMMUNITY PARK (ABC) - 801 Adams Blvd. Hours vary for the **Art Ctr, Fitness Ctr & Weight Room, the Youth Ctr, Gymnasium & classrooms.**

11 BICENTENNIAL PARK - 1100 Colorado St. 7 acres of beautiful green grass & trees for your enjoyment. Excellent for a family get-together. The **gazebo band-stand**, built for the Bicentennial Celebration, is an excellent covered facility for special events. Park also includes a children's play area.

9 BOOTLEG CANYON MOUNTAIN BIKE RACING - 1000 Yucca St. Outstanding trails, beautiful lake views & well-maintained trails. Lower trails are beginner; higher trails are intermediate & expert runs. Open daily, excluding practices & races. Note: Use of safety equipment is strongly recommended. Please leave the area in the same, if not better, condition as when you arrived. Location: Turn north on Yucca St. & head toward the BC on Red Mtn. Veer right at the gravel pit to go around counter-clockwise. Follow the signs to the parking area. 19 & 20 BRAVO SOFTBALL FIELD & WHALEN BASEBALL FIELD - 891 Avenue B. These **ball fields** accommodate the Youth & Men's & Women's Baseball & Softball Leagues & Youth Soccer programs. Together, they cover approximately 7 acres. Fields are available for reservations by calling the Recreation Department. Night reservations are available.

4 DEL PRADO PARK - 901 Utah. This 2.5-acre park has playground equipment, **basketball courts** & open green areas.

10 FRANK T. CROWE MEMORIAL PARK - 640 Nevada Way. Approximately 1-acre of open green area includes picnic tables & barbecue grills.

13 HEMENWAY VALLEY PARK - 110 Ville Drive. This park is comprised of approximately 10 acres. Includes playground equipment, multi-level play structure, gazebo, restrooms, picnic area, **basketball courts, 2 lighted tennis courts & 2 lighted softball fields.** This lovely park has a fantastic view of Lake Mead.

16 LAKEVIEW PARK - 103 Walker Way. A 3/4-acre park with a tot lot, playground, **basketball court**, picnic tables, barbecue grills, trees & green open space.

6 NEVADA WAY RECREATION FACILITY - DEPT. OF WATER & POWER BLDG. (DWP) - 600 Nevada Way.

15 OASIS PARK - 1419 Marita Dr. 5 acres of beautiful open green area. Enjoy the **ball field, basketball courts**, playground equipment or the para-course.

4 RECREATION CENTER - 900 Arizona St. Hours vary for the administrative offices, **class-rooms, & gymnasiums.**

17 REFLECTIONS CENTER - 300 Railroad Ave. Beautifully landscaped with 7 sculptures, changing each year, may be enjoyed from any of the many park benches provided along the walkway.

7 RIVER MOUNTAIN HIKING TRAIL - Lakeview Subdivision & Hwy 93. A 56-year-old hiking trail built by the Civilian Conservation Corps, lies between Red & Black Mountain. Boulder City, the National Park Service & the UNLV Geology Department have renovated the 5-1/2 mile trail. Look for the trailhead sign.

3 ROBERT N BROADBENT MEMORIAL PARK - 861 Avenue B. 5 acres encompass a variety of recreational facilities including 4 lighted **tennis courts**, picnic areas, play areas, **Multi-Use Building** - 1204 6th St with kitchen & dining area, **swimming pool / racquetball courts** & more.

3 SWIMMING POOL /RACQUETBALL COMPLEX 861 Avenue B.

22 VETERANS' MEMORIAL PARK 1650 Buchanan Blvd & Airport Rd. This new park is comprised of 25 acres. It includes 4 lighted multi-use **ball fields**, 2 beach **volleyball courts**, open green space, **skateboard & bike parks, 2 soccer fields, a splash park & picnic area** & a restroom area. Nearby is a 4 acre **fishing pond in addition to a model boat pond** & 5 acres of land leased to the Girl Scout Council. Plans call for a picnic / BBQ area.

Park reservations are on a 1st come, 1st serve basis.
