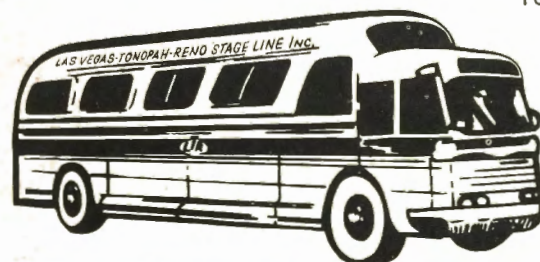
SCOUTING REPORT
