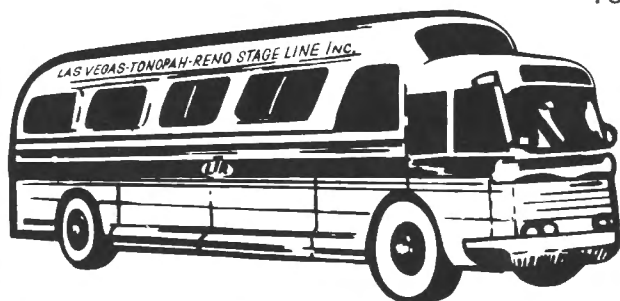
#### SCOUTING REPORT

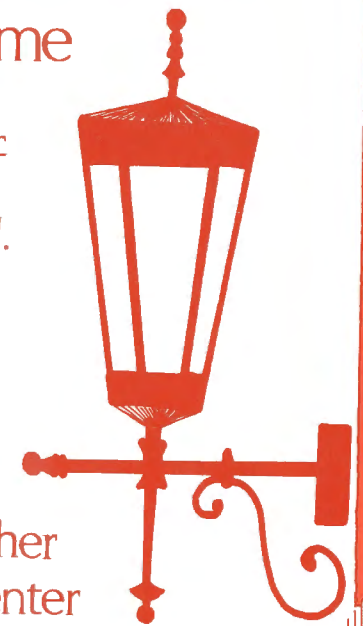
