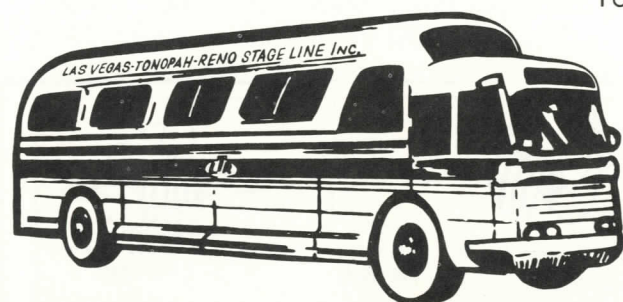
SCOUTING REPORT
