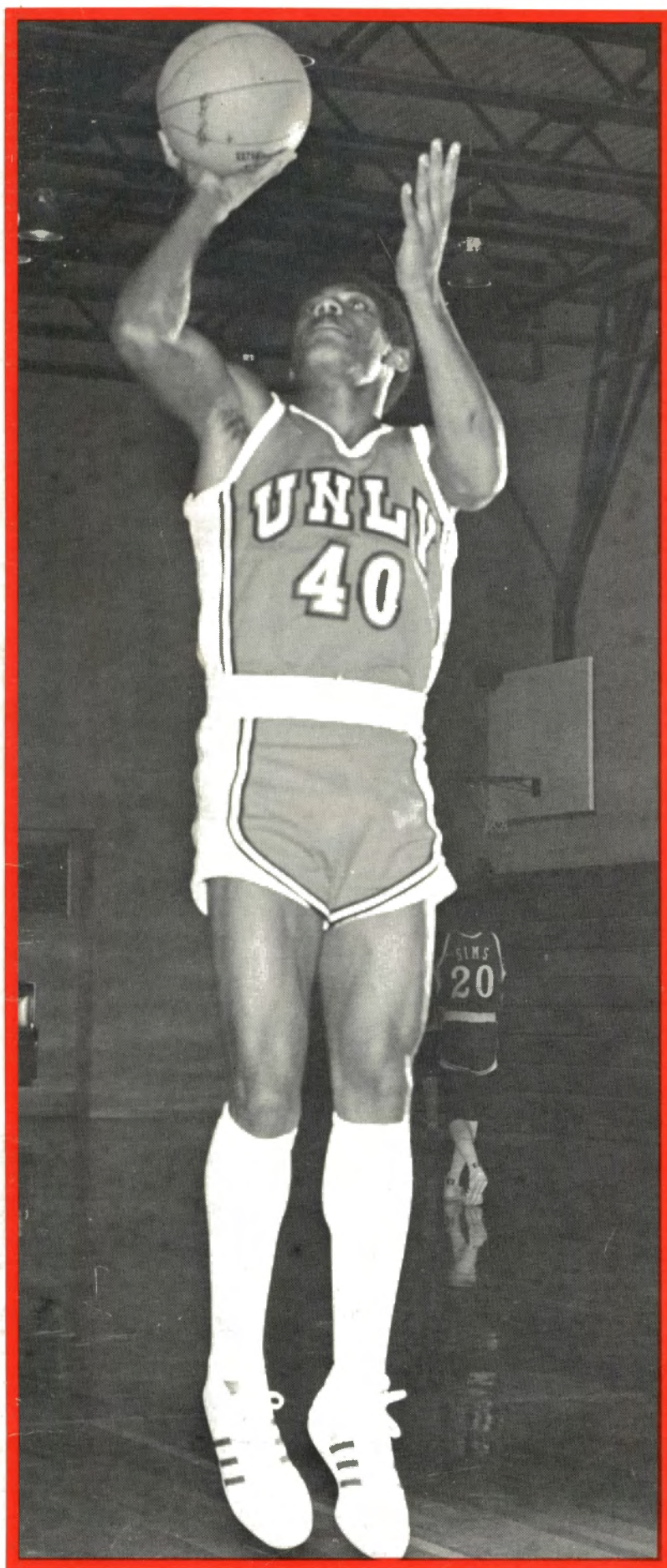

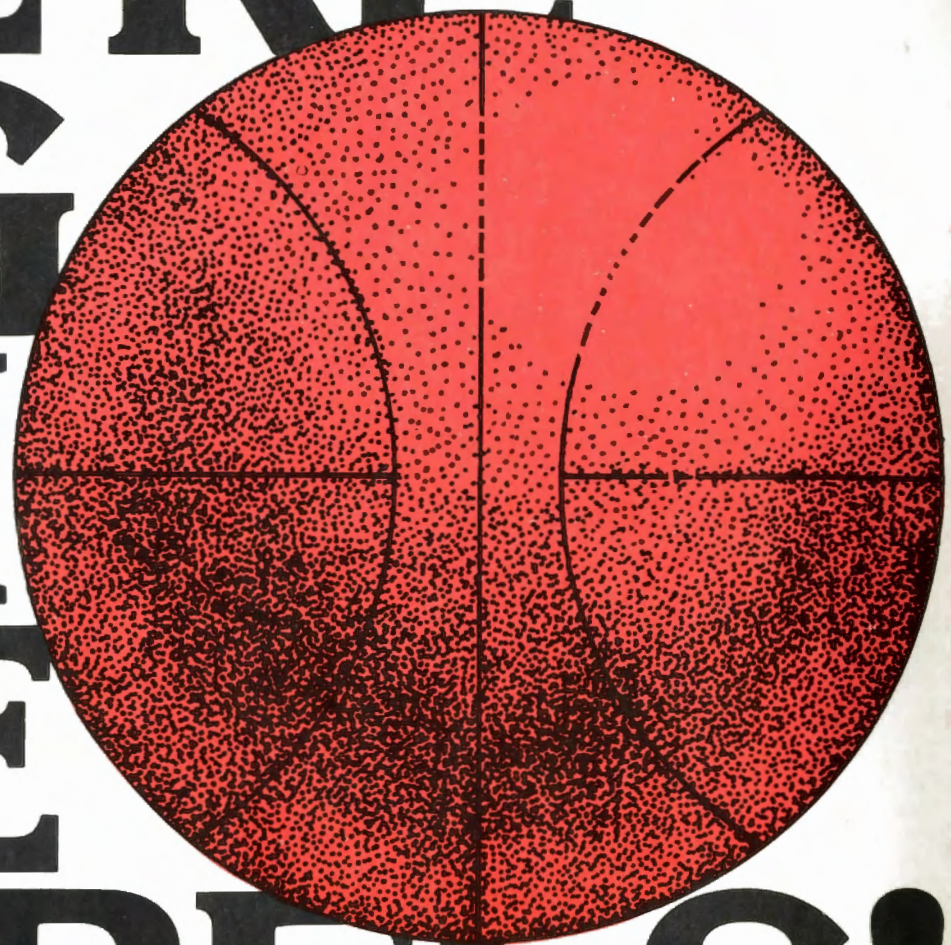

There is not a stronger more influential group supporting a college athletic program than UNLV's own University Rebels Club. Growing right along with the program over the past 19 years, the URC continues to be the driving force behind booster support for the 16-sport UNLV intercollegiate athletic program. The membership roles continue to grow daily as the group becomes one of the most prominent in the entire intercollegiate athletic world in America.

This past summer, the URC culminated its greatest fund-raising drive ever bringing in over \$1 million for the support of the grant-in-aid program for Rebel athletics. This total once again is one of the very top in the entire nation, especially for schools without large endowment funds and lengthy lists of graduates over man-decades.

The honorary list of UNLV alumni is one of the largest as the record drive indicates all the thousands of Rebel supporters there are in Las Vegas. The P & P boys who continue to ramrod the organization and the administrative duties of the URC are Davey Pearl and Dr. Wayne Pearson.

Davey, the energetic little fireball who could just about be able to talk President Carter into giving the Rebels the White House to use for some function, is the coordinator for booster support activities at UNLV while the reputable Dr. Pearson is the director of fund-raising for UNLV athletics.

The new president, but certainly no stranger to the organization, is Tom Wiesner, the prominent Las Vegas businessman and long-time Rebel booster.

The 15-man board of directors meets monthly and their are a minimum of two annual meetings of all the UNLV athletic donors.

And, then, there are the visiting honorary alumni like Dr. Frank Sinatra who has performed for the Rebel "Thank You" concerts for the last three years. On August 23, of this year, Dr. Sinatra led an evening at the sold out 7,500-seat Aladdin Theatre For the Performing Arts with fellow stars Dean Martin, Jerry Lewis, Paul Anka, Jackie Gayle, The Third Generation Steps and Dave Burton. Each of the past three years, Dr. Sinatra has given us even more memories for a lifetime.

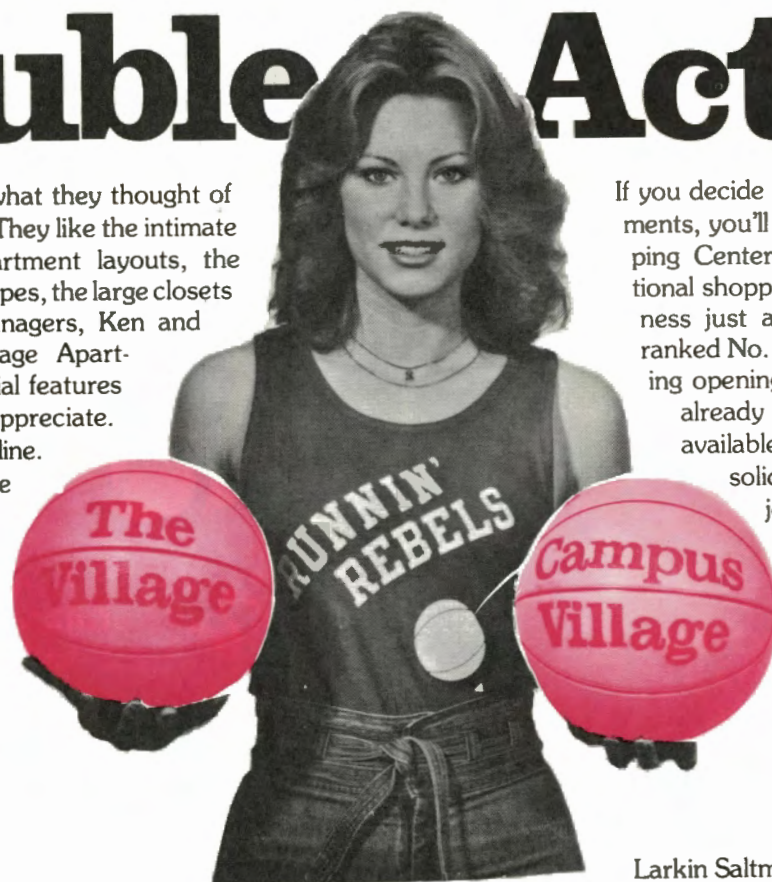

JERRY TARKANIAN: Head Coach

UNLV Runnin' Rebel basketball has come a long, long way. It wouldn't have advanced to the NCAA finals and the NCAA playoffs and been rated in the top 20 the past three seasons if it hadn't been for Jerry Tarkanian, the winningest active major college basketball coach in America. After nine seasons of coaching Division I basketball, Tarkanian has won 224 games and lost only 36 for a brilliant .862 winning percentage.

In four seasons as UNLV's head coach, Tarkanian has led the Rebels to records of 20-6, 24-5, 29-2 and 29-3. The goal of the players who were with Tarkanian each of the four years he has been at UNLV had a goal to win 100 games, a goal they established for themselves as freshmen. When Eddie Owens, Glen Gondrezick, Lewis Brown, Robert Smith, and Sam Smith left UNLV after the 1976-77 season, their four year total was 102-16 — an amazing record for an astounding group of players.

After four seasons, Tarkanian's record of 102-16 is a winning percentage of .864.

UNLV won the Western Regional Championship during the 1976-77 season and finished with the third-place trophy in the NCAA Finals in Atlanta, Georgia last March. To get there, the Runnin' Rebels established 14 NCAA single-game, single-season, and tournament records. In the playoffs, UNLV defeated the University of San Francisco, 121-95, the University of Utah, 88-83, Idaho State University 107-90 in the Western Regionals. Then UNLV lost a heartbreaker, 84-83 to the University of North Carolina and defeated the University of North Carolina, Charlotte, 106-94 in the NCAA Finals.

In 1975-76, UNLV won its first 23 games, ended at 29-2 with a lofty third place rating in the Associated Press poll.

Winning is a fact of life to Jerry Tarkanian, on the court and off. In 20 years of coaching in the collegiate, high school and junior college ranks, the fourth-year Rebel coach has known nothing but success.

In nine seasons as a major college coach, his teams have appeared in seven NCAA post-season tournaments in addition to his being the winningest active major college coach.

What is equally amazing is that Tarkanian NEVER lost a home game while coaching at Long Beach State. His 49er teams won 65 straight home games in the campus gym and Long Beach arena, culminating with a nationally-televised impressive 77-66 victory over Marquette.

At UNLV, Tark's troops have won 59 straight games going into the 1977-78 season, and, in three seasons, the Runnin' Rebels have a spectacular 67-2 record in the friendly, yet boisterous, surroundings of the Las Vegas Convention Center.

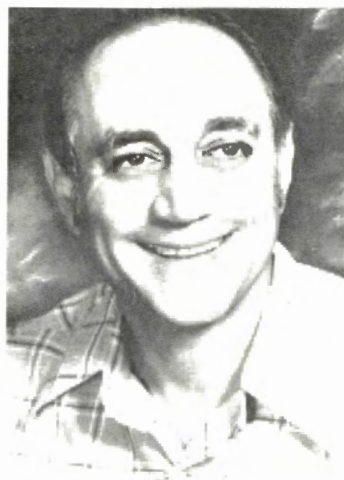
On Runnin' Rebel game nights, the otherwise stately convention hall is turned into a mass of theatrical light explosions which quickly works the crowd into a frenzy — and that's why a prominently-placed sign welcomes visitors with "Welcome to Tark's Shark Tank."

The only two teams who dared to defeat the Runnin' Rebels were both in the 1973-74 season when the freshman-laden squad fell to Texas Tech, 82-76, and to the University of Houston, 75-72. The freshmen avenged the Houston loss in 1976, beating the Cougars in the opening round of the Holiday Classic 116-92.

Sellout crowds have been traditional at UNLV in the Tarkanian era. In the Rebels' two WCAC seasons with Tarkanian, UNLV did not lose a home game in 14 nights. (UNLV has now withdrawn from the WCAC and competes as a Division I team.) In four seasons under Tarkanian, UNLV is 30-12 on the road.

In NCAA playoff action after the 1974-75 season, the Rebels played a sub-regional game on the campus of Arizona State in Tempe, defeating San Diego State, 90-80. In the NCAA Regional tournament in Portland, Oregon, the Rebels were narrowly trimmed by Arizona State, 84-81, but bounced back in the consolation game to defeat a favored University of Montana team, 75-67.

Following the 1975-75 campaign, the Runnin' Rebels defeated Boise State, 103-78, in a sub-regional game played on



the campus of the University of Oregon in Eugene. Then the Runnin' Rebels were knocked out of the race for the national championship, losing to the University of Arizona, 114-109, in overtime, at fabled Pauley Pavilion.

Before Long Beach, where Tarkanian's reputation first drew national acclaim, he spent seven seasons in the junior college ranks at Riverside and Pasadena City Colleges. At Riverside (1962-66), he had a 131-9 overall record, which included three consecutive state championships and four league championships in five years. No other junior college coach in the history of California basketball has achieved those heights. At Pasadena (1966-68), Tarkanian was 67-4 and bagged a fourth state title while another year finishing in the runner-up spot.

An astonishing feature of his wins is that they were accomplished at schools which had never previously won a basketball championship. Riverside was last in its conference for two consecutive years before Tarkanian; Pasadena was last in its conference the previous year; Long Beach had never won a championship in basketball; and UNLV had never finished higher than fourth in the WCAC.

The outstanding coach started his coaching career with five years in high schools: San Joaquin Memorial, Antelope Valley and Redlands.

Regarded as one of the great recruiters in the nation, "The Pied Piper of College Basketball" landed for Long Beach such nationally recognized superstars as Sam Robinson, George Trapp, Chuck Terry, Ed Ratleff, Leonard Gray and Roscoe Pondexter. In his first year at UNLV, Tarkanian may have recruited as well as he did during his entire tenure at Long Beach State.

As his winning tradition continues to grow, so does his reputation. Four years ago Tarkanian brought three high school All-America performers with him. They are Eddie Owens (Houston, Texas), Lewis Brown and Jackie Robinson (both Los Angeles).

Three years ago he recruited Robert Smith (Los Angeles), last year he brought in Sam Smith (Las Vegas) and Reggie Theus (Inglewood, California). For last season, he has all-star junior college center Larry Moffett.

Jerry Tarkanian is a towel-chewing, nail biting, hard-working Armenian who came to Las Vegas with a commitment to excellence as his inspiring philosophy. He will settle for nothing less than excellence from his players, both on and off the court. In addition to a nationally-recognized basketball program for UNLV, Tarkanian has developed a tutorial program for his players that has paid high dividends. A trademark of Tarkanian players is that they almost without exception, earn their college degrees, even though some of them do it during the off-season while they are in professional basketball.

UNLV attempts to emphasize equally the importance of academics and basketball to all student-athletes.

Evidence of his strong belief in academics was his selection as "Professor of the Year" in 1970 by the students of Long Beach State. He was also honored as the "Father of the Year" in 1966 by Riverside County for his "guidance and care on and off the court of all the young men under his tutelage, as well as his family of four."

Tarkanian's players have gone on to play in professional basketball. They include Chuck Terry (Houston Rockets), Eric McWilliams (Houston Rockets), George Trapp (Detroit Pistons), Bob Rule (Cleveland Cavaliers), Ed Ratleff (Houston Rockets), John Q. Trapp (Los Angeles Lakers), Glenn MacDonald (Boston Celtics), Leonard Gray (Seattle Supersonics), and most recently Rickey Sobers (Indiana Pacers). Darrell Evans, who played for Tarkanian in junior college, is a starter for the Atlanta Braves in major league baseball.

Last year, Tark's players set an NBA and NCAA record. All six eligible Rebels were drafted by NBA clubs. Seniors Eddie Owens (Kansas City), Glen Gondrezick (New York Knicks), Sam Smith (Atlanta), Lewis Brown (Milwaukee), Robert Smith (Denver), joined junior Larry Moffett (Houston) on the record-breaking draft list.

An intense individual, Tark has coached in Ecuador for the People-to-People Sports Committee and, in April and May of 1968, he coached the Junior College Olympic Team in the Olympic Trials.

The 46-year-old coach easily won the hearts of Las Vegas fans, and the Los Angeles Times called him an "instant Las Vegas celebrity."

A true champion builder, when he arrived at Long Beach the team was unknown nationally. When he left, it was an established power, second in the West only to UCLA.

A native of Euclid, Ohio, Tarkanian attended Pasadena City College before graduating from Fresno State in 1956. He received his Master's degree from Redlands University in 1960.

Tarkanian and his ever-active and totally-involved wife, Lois, reside with their four children Pamela, Jodie, Danny and George — in their sparkling Las Vegas home.

With Tarkanian's tradition and image, invitations for him to speak at clinics and banquets arrive almost daily. He will average nearly one per week during the off-season, sending him all over the country.

Las Vegas is one of the most unique cities in the world, one which sees losers every day. Maybe that's why they appreciate a man like Jerry Tarkanian even more. He's a winner.

Ralph Readout returns for his fourth season as an assistant coach under Jerry Tarkanian.

This exuberant coach has 14 years of head coaching experience at the prep level in Ohio, where he established winning programs at four schools.

He has an extensive back ground in many fields, having earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Education from Ohio University in 1953, and his Master of Arts degree in Educational Administration from Ohio State University in 1961. Readout attended Ohio University on a scholastic scholarship

and graduated with honors from Ohio State's graduate school. He was a stellar basketball player while at Ohio U.

Tark's assistant is an intense and enthusiastic coach with keen insight into the learning process and psychological applications of coaching. His approach to basketball coaching is firmly based on psychological motivation and his contributions to the success of last year's 29-3 record-breaking Rebel team were indeed significant.

He was quite an athlete at Ohio University: he played not only basketball, but baseball as well, he was a three-year letterman starter and was elected captain of his basketball team.

He has a great relationship with the Rebel players and has the innate ability to communicate on all levels with those whom he is associated.

He first came to UNLV in 1973 and served as an assistant football coach under Ron Meyer (who is now at SMU), working with the defensive secondary.

Ralph and his wife, Dottie, are thoroughly enamored with the Las Vegas community.

A three-year Runnin' Rebel letterman, Mike Milke, is expected to make strong contributions this season. He has always been a hardworking, determined and quietly consistent player and this should be his year with UNLV.

In three seasons with UNLV, he hasn't scored too much or even played too much but his presence has been felt on the practice court, where coach Tarkanian has said many times that games are won or lost. He practices like he were a starter and not only has this helped him perfect his game, it also has given the regulars something tough to go against on a day-to-day basis.

He could have gone to other schools of lesser quality and been a starter, but he has courageously chosen to stay at UNLV and be a vital, if not spectacular part of a growing and winning program.

Last season Mike played 96 minutes in 20 games, scoring 32 points and giving out 27 assists.

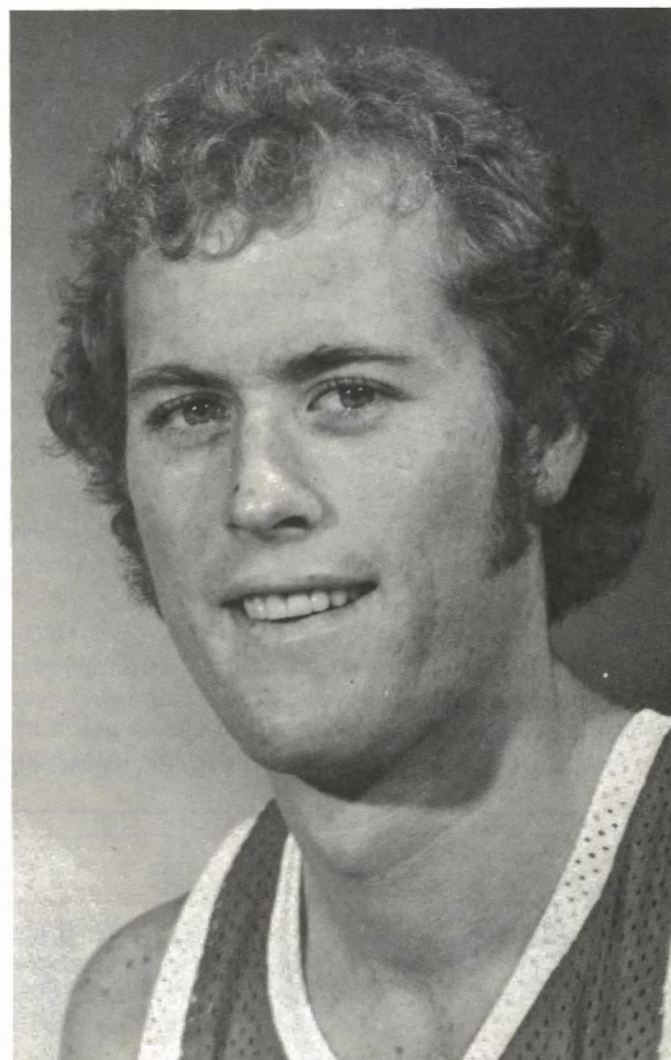
As a freshman, Milke proved he could make the big play: he came off the bench late in the final minutes of the crucial road game against St. Mary's to sink three challenging free throws to ice and 81-75 Rebel victory.

Milke is a soft-spoken, likeable young man from Hilltop High School in his hometown of Chula Vista, California, where he earned numerous honors and played in the San Diego prep All-Star game as well.

As a three-year starter in high school, he ended his prep career by averaging 21.3 points per game in addition to handing off eight assists per game and pulling down six rebounds in each contest.

Milke is from a very athletic family. His father retired in 1972 after coaching for 20 years (during which he even coached against Tarkanian a few times). His brother George was a starting pitcher for the University of Southern California Trojans and was named MVP of the 1974 College World Series in Omaha, Nebraska.



Milke hopes to become a coach after graduation from UNLV next spring, but for now, he will continue to do his very best to help the Runnin' Rebels do the finest job they can in every game they play.

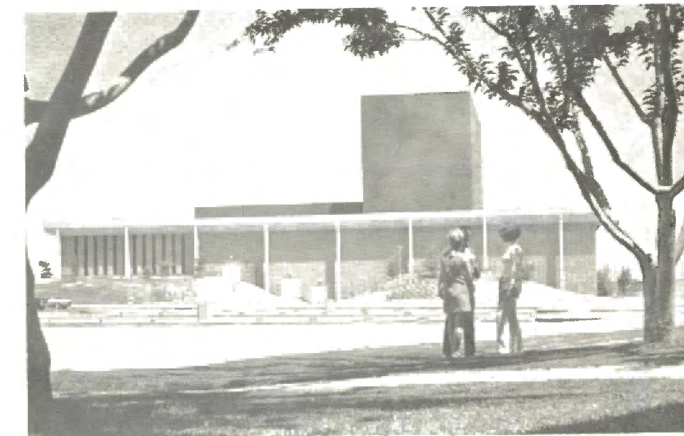
The university also has a progressive teacher education program, a growing nursing department, solid preparation of students in the social sciences, the humanities, business and economics.

UNLV also reaches out into the community through its aggressive continuing education programs that last year enrolled 15,000 local residents.

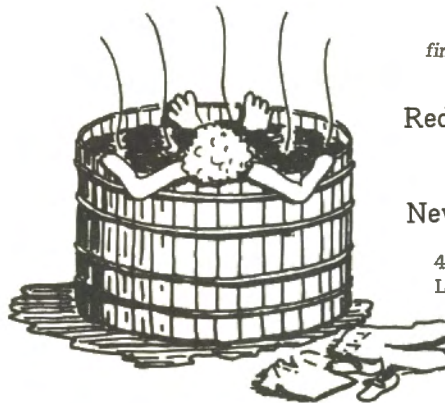
The outlook is bright for UNLV as it completes its 20th year of service to Nevada through its programs of teaching, reasearch and public service.

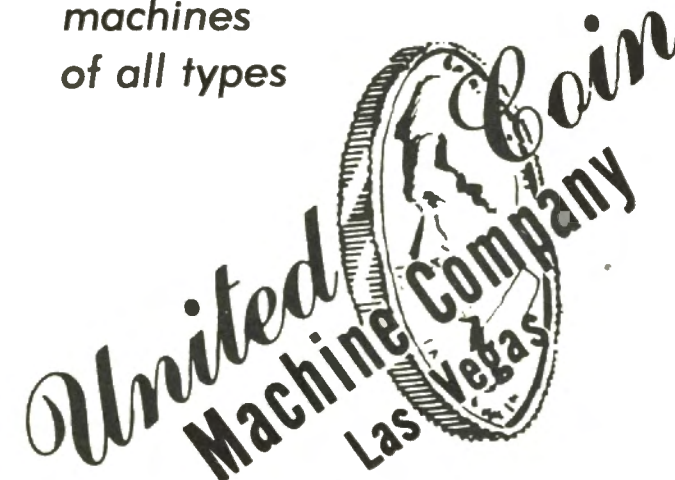

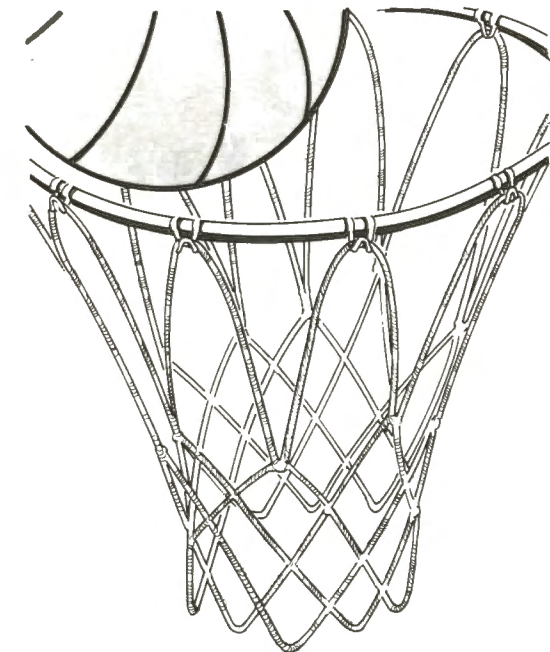

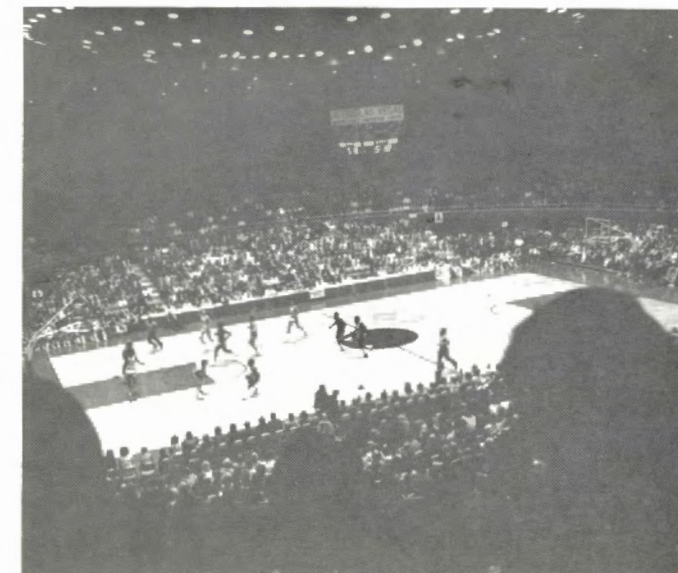
UNLV plays all of its home games on one of the finest hardwood court arenas in the country — the 6,357 seat Las Vegas Convention Center rotunda. Capacity crowds cheer the Rebels in comfort from theater-type cushioned seats. Ample parking is available at the conveniently located facility, one mile east of the fabled Las Vegas Strip.

UNLV certainly enjoys playing in its home facility; as a matter of record, going into the 1977-78 season, The Runnin' Rebels have won 59 straight games in the Center. Jerry Tarkanian's four-season total in the Convention Center is 67-2 against regular NCAA competition. This year, UNLV will play 19 games in the boisterous facility.

In 1976-77, UNLV played 19 home games again, scoring 2,109 points for an average of 111.0 per game. Once again, the Runnin' Rebels had 16 games of 100 or more points and in a pre-season exhibition game against the National Team of the Republic of China, UNLV pumped in 174 points.

The Convention Center has also been SOLD OUT for the past four seasons, with only very limited seating available for a few games.

Producing the elaborate light shows during pre-game ceremonies again this season will be a long-time Rebel supporter, Art Rader.

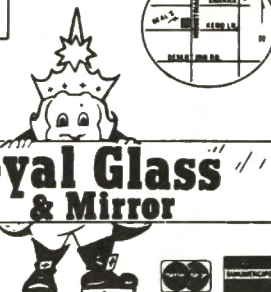

The world-premiere of Sulich's "Slavonic Dances," inspired by the choreographer's Yugoslavic childhood and upbringing, will be tinged with the ethnic dances of several Eastern European countries.

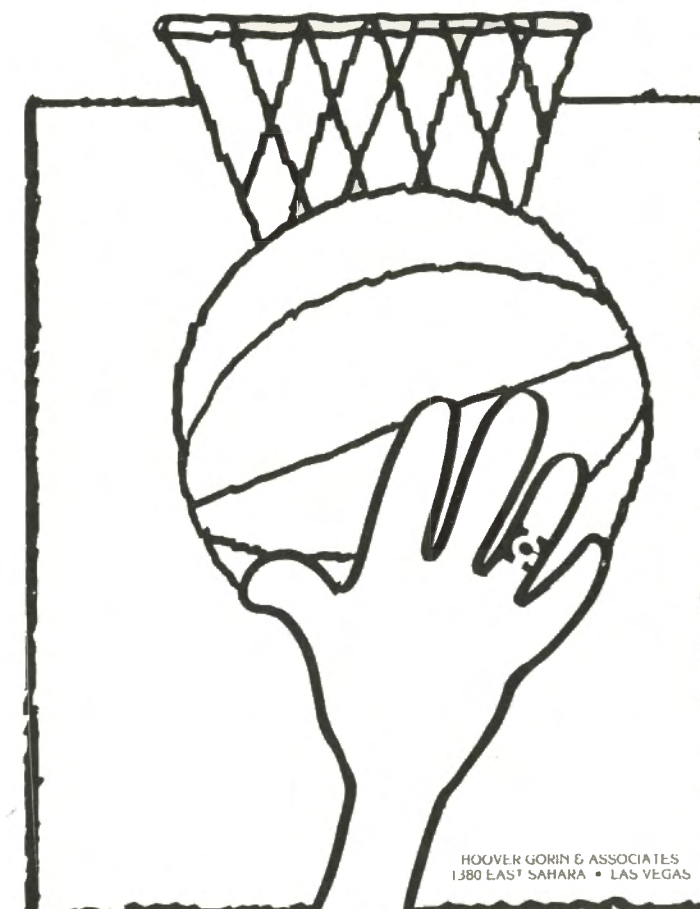

Carns said season tickets at a reduced price to the company's December and February concerts are also now available at the box office.

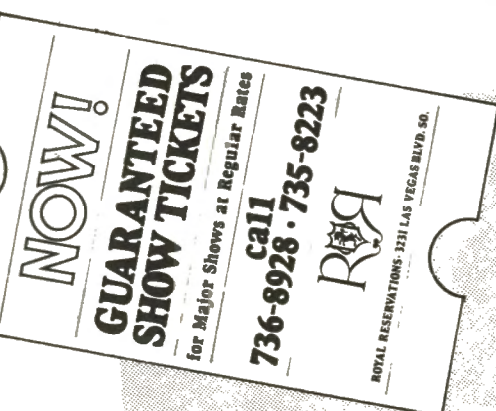

The UNLV Runnin' Rebels versus the San Diego State Aztecs — a classic matchup that will soon become a regular occurrence when both schools are accepted into the Western Athletic Conference. The teams will begin playing on a home-and-home basis next season.

The Aztecs, after routing Drake in the opening game, 100-72, has been up against some stiff competition in their last few ball games. San Diego took on Arizona last Friday evening, and Nevada-Reno, the following night.

Head Aztec basketball coach Tim Vezie has eight lettermen returning from last year's 13-15 ballclub, which won six of its last seven regular season contests, and finished in a tie for the PCAA title. He also has additional help from last season's redshirts Steve Malovic, Hilton Hale and Rock Lee.

Leading the border-city ballteam are forwards Percy Gilbert (6-5) and Joel Kramer (6-7). Last season as a freshman, Gilbert led the team in scoring with a 15.4 average and was credited with 36 "slam dunks."

Kramer, a senior, was named All-Conference last year and led the team in rebounding with a 9.2 average. He also chipped in with an 11.3 scoring average. In the opening game against Drake, Kramer matched his career high with 22 points. He also pulled down 15 rebounds.

Also back for the Aztecs are center Fred Branch (6-9½), forwards Brett Davis (6-7) and Jerry Brown (6-8), guards Mike Dodd (6-5) and Ia Saipaia (6-3), and pointman Dean Decker (6-0).

All of the redshirts are possible starters and all will see considerable action throughout this season. Malovic (6-11) played at USC two years ago and was the no. 2 rebounder in the PAC-8 that year. Hale was a starter at Northwestern and Lee played at California before switching schools.

The top newcomers for San Diego State are JC All-America Kim Goetz (6-7) and seven-foot freshman Brett Barnett from Glendale, California.

All-in-all San Diego can field one of the tallest teams in the country with 7-0 Barnett, 6-11 Malovic, 6-10 Lee, 6-9½ Branch and 6-7 performers Kramer and Goetz.

Meanwhile the Runnin' Rebels have been suffering through some early season growing pains. With six truly sensational players lost from last year's team, it will take some time for all the bugs to be worked out. The team has won without playing its best, nor anywhere near up to its full potential. But it may take even more time before the players become completely accustomed to one another on the court.

This is the third of a fifteen game home stand which extends from early December until mid-January. This part of the Runnin' Rebels schedule can only help the team prepare for that tough latter section of road games. Here in the friendly confines of the Las Vegas Convention Center the Rebels can work on their game and teamwork and get that familiar high-scoring well-oiled machine in gear for those brutal games at Marquette, New Mexico, Louisville, Maryland and Kentucky.

The Rebels hold a 4-2 edge over the Aztecs in their previous meetings, including a 118-113 victory last December 11th in San Diego. That game drew 5,221 — the 4th largest in San Diego history. Back in the 1974-75 season the Rebels eliminated San Diego, 90-80, in the first round of the NCAA Western Regionals.

UNLV ENTERS WAC, DIVISION 1

UNLV has been officially admitted to the Western Athletic Conference, becoming eligible for league titles in all conference sports with the 1980-81 academic year.

The Rebels will begin a WAC schedule in both football and basketball, however, during the 1978-79 year. In 1978, the Rebel football team will play all WAC schools except Hawaii and the University of Utah.

Long a prestigious conference in the Rocky Mountain area, the WAC expanded West this year after the University of Arizona and Arizona State jumped the fence over to the Pacific-8 which will become the Pacific-10.

The WAC then selected San Diego State, Hawaii and UNLV to fill the two spots. San Diego State becomes eligible for league titles in 1978-79, Hawaii 1979-80 and then UNLV the following year.

Two conditions which UNLV must meet by 1980 are adequate facilities (large enough seating) for both football and basketball. The football stadium will be expanded to 30,000 seats for the 1978 season and the plans have been approved to construct an 18,000-seat basketball arena on the UNLV campus.

This is a big step forward for the entire Rebel athletic program, especially football, and athletic director Bill Ireland, school president Dr. Donald Baepier and the University Rebels Club are to be thanked.

Center which also houses most athletic offices. The arena was built at a cost of \$9.5 million and serves a myriad of purposes for the university community.

The Miners also began play at an on-campus baseball facility last spring.

Colorado State and Utah both have solid facilities already in existence but have not shied away from improvements. Both added (and sold out) booster club/scholarship donor booths in their football stadium while Utah recently refurbished all of Rice Stadium. Both universities have great all-purpose arenas.

Football stadium expansion is in the wings for both Brigham Young and New Mexico. The Cougars are looking at plans to add somewhere in the neighborhood of 15,000 seats to BYU Stadium. New Mexico is earnestly working on plans to enlarge its 31,000 seat University Stadium.

In basketball BYU and UNM have few peers. The Marriott Center at Provo seats just under 23,000, second largest (to Kentucky) on-campus facility in the country. The Lobos recently enlarged University Arena, more affectionately called "The Pit," to seat 17,121. Both teams are among the national leaders annually in basketball attendance.

The facilities aren't the only thing changing in the WAC. The membership will vary the next few years with Arizona and Arizona State departing and San Diego State (July 1, 1978), Hawaii (July 1, 1979) and Nevada-Las Vegas (July 1, 1980) scheduled to enter the ranks.

Collegiate athletic voice

NCAA serves nation's schools

Progress and growth have become familiar companions for the National Collegiate Athletic Association during its first 71 years as the major governing organization for intercollegiate athletics in the United States.

A call for stricter control of college football by President Theodore Roosevelt because of the violence in the game brought together 13 institutions in 1905, formulating the original communications base for college athletics.

This initial body called itself the Intercollegiate Athletic Association and was officially constituted March 31, 1906. In 1910, the name was changed to the National Collegiate Athletic Association.

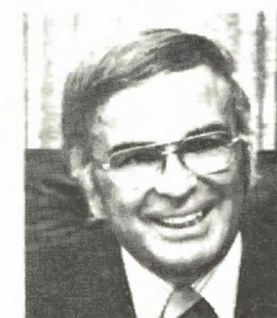
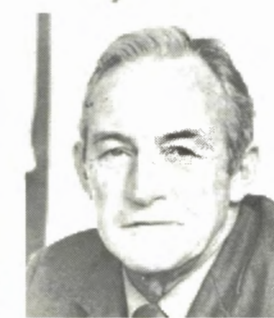
Seven progressive decades have molded this original 13-member body into a membership today of more than 800 colleges, universities, conferences and affiliated organizations.

Administration and rules interpretation occupied early efforts of the organization. Shortly after World War II, the NCAA adopted legislative and executive powers, changing its function into one dealing with virtually all issues concerned with intercollegiate athletics.

Service first

Many things have become associated with the NCAA during its colorful history. Highest priority goes to the service it provides to more than 800 members, acting as the true "voice" of college athletics today.

Each January the NCAA membership comes together at the annual Convention to review, propose and amend legislation. The Convention presents the opportunity for the na-

tion's institutions of higher learning to speak and act on athletic matters at the national level.

Acting in the best interests of its membership, the NCAA strives to perform these specific functions among its many other responsibilities:

- Conducts 39 annual National Collegiate Championships in 18 sports for three separate divisions. Three championships (Division I, Division II and Division III) are held in baseball, basketball, cross country, golf, soccer, swimming, tennis, outdoor track and wrestling. Two championships (Division I and Divisions II-III) are staged in gymnastics and lacrosse. Fencing, ice hockey, skiing, indoor track, volleyball and water polo hold single National Collegiate Championships, while football is contested in Division II and Division III. The National Collegiate Championship dates back to 1883 in tennis; and during this 94-year history, more than 75,000 student-athletes have competed in these events, with more than 9,000 earning

the coveted title of "National Collegiate Champion."

- Maintains 13 rules committees to formulate, copyright and publish rules of play for the government of collegiate sports. Members of these and many other committees are elected by representatives of member institutions at the annual Convention.

- Publishes "Official Guides" annually for nine sports through the NCAA Publishing Service.

... Collects, compiles and distributes the official statistics of college football, basketball and baseball through its NCAA Statistics Service.

Problem solver

- Conducts studies as a means of developing solutions to athletic programs.

- Represents the membership in legislative and regulatory matters on the state and Federal levels.

- Annually selects the College Athletics Top Ten, the Award of Valor and the Theodore Roosevelt ("Teddy") Award—the Association's highest honor.

- Administers an honors program which annually awards 80 postgraduate scholarships to recognize outstanding senior student-athletes who have excelled in the classroom as well as athletics. This scholarship was increased from \$1,000 to \$1,500 in 1975-76. The program has provided \$1,024,000 to 944 recipients since its inception in the 1964-65 academic year.

- Supports the United States Collegiate Sports Council (USCSC) and participates in the World University Games movement by supplying funds, coaches, athletes and facilities for international competition.

- Maintains more than 60 full-time staff members at its national headquarters in Mission, Kansas, under the supervision of Executive Director Walter Byers.

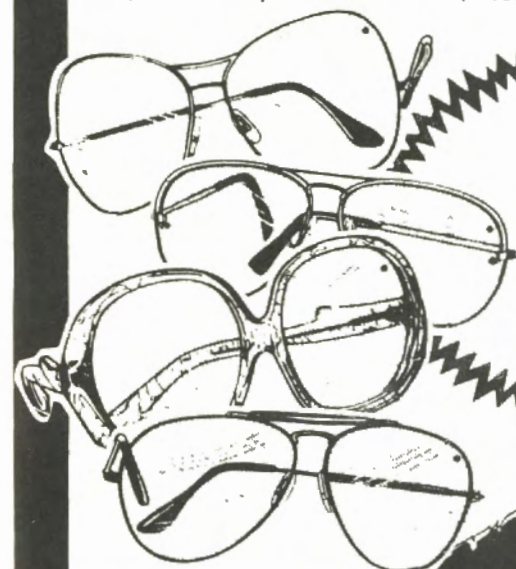

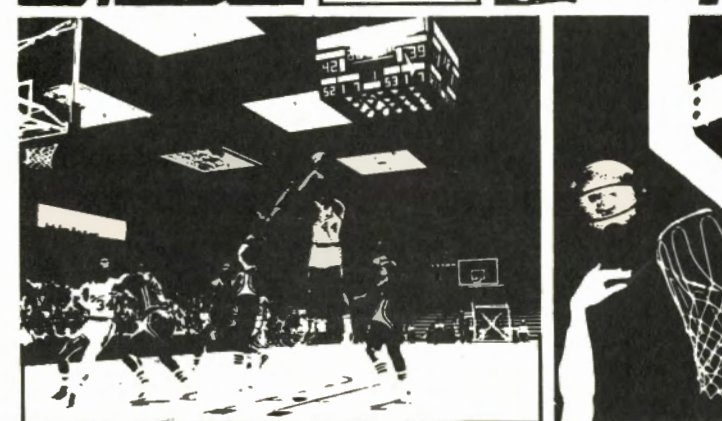

WAC SPORTS

While you are sitting here in comfortable surroundings, watching your favorite Western Athletic Conference team in action, the athletic departments at all conference universities are striving to make their spectator facilities second to none.

The WAC must be headed in the right direction. Comfortable surroundings along with hard-fought competition in football and basketball last year led to record attendance figures in both sports. Some 1,316,684 fans watched 45 home football games in 1976 while 1,139,494 of you saw the 118 home basketball contests, both were better than 10 percent increases over the previous year.

What's underway currently or what has been completed and what does the future hold in the area of WAC athletic facilities? Here's a look:

Winning football and basketball has brought about other changes in Wyoming. The Cowboys recently added an upper deck to the west side of Memorial Stadium and are currently expanding the east side with a similar deck to raise the capacity to 32,500. In basketball, Memorial Fieldhouse soon will say goodbye to the dirt floor, high ceiling and portable wooden floor. Cowboy fans will see theater type seating, a permanent wood floor surrounded by an artificial surface which will allow tennis and volleyball type activity to be staged in the arena. The ceiling will be lowered also and the dirt floor will vanish.

Texas-El Paso, fresh from adding artificial turf at the Sun Bowl and dressing up the locker rooms, opened last spring its 12,000 seat Special Events

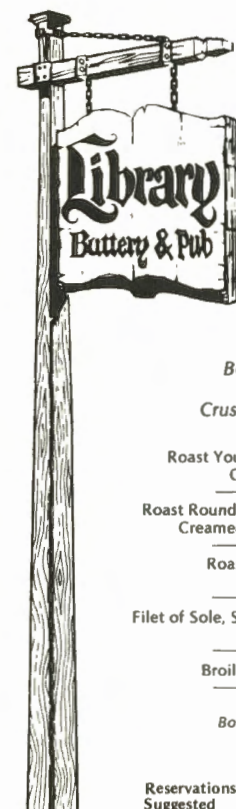

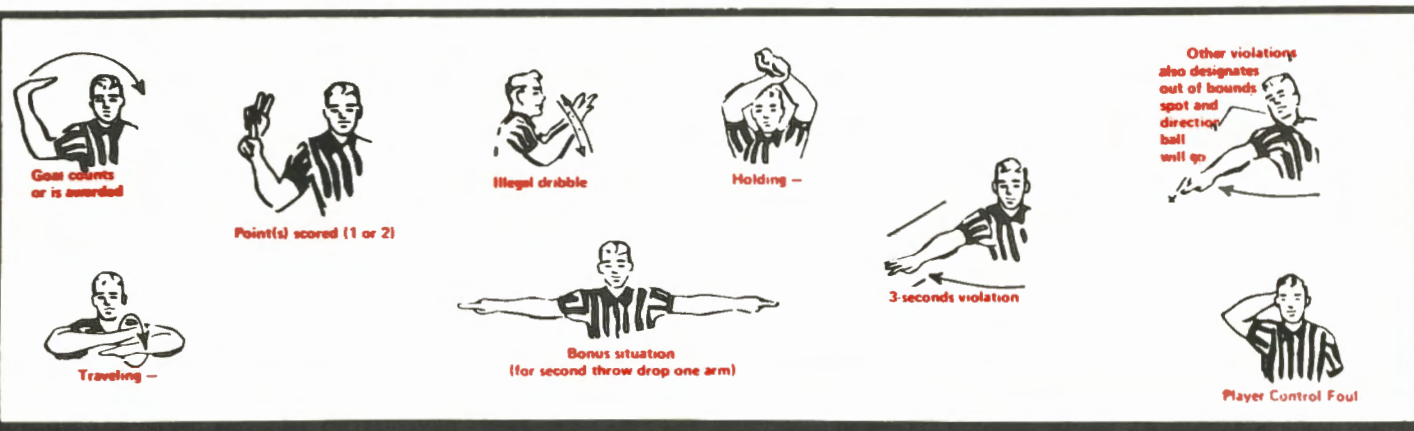
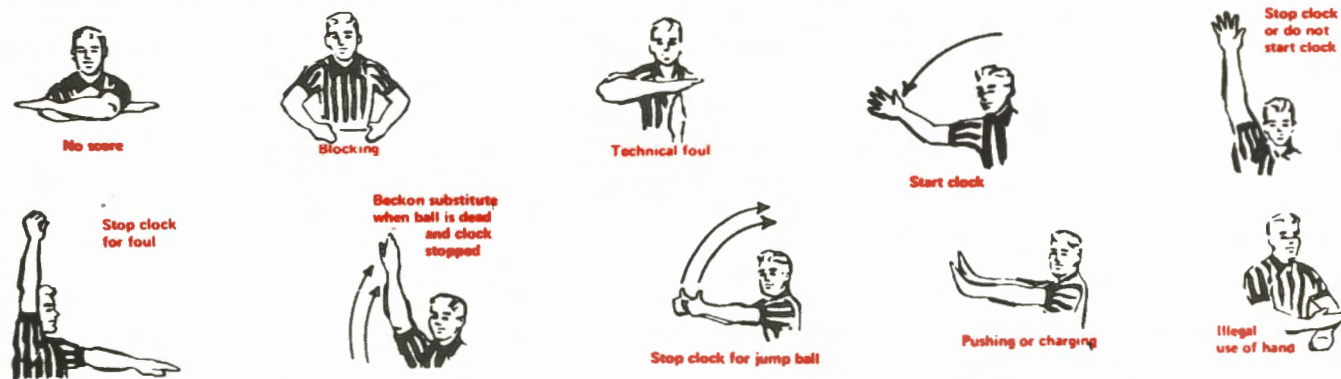
