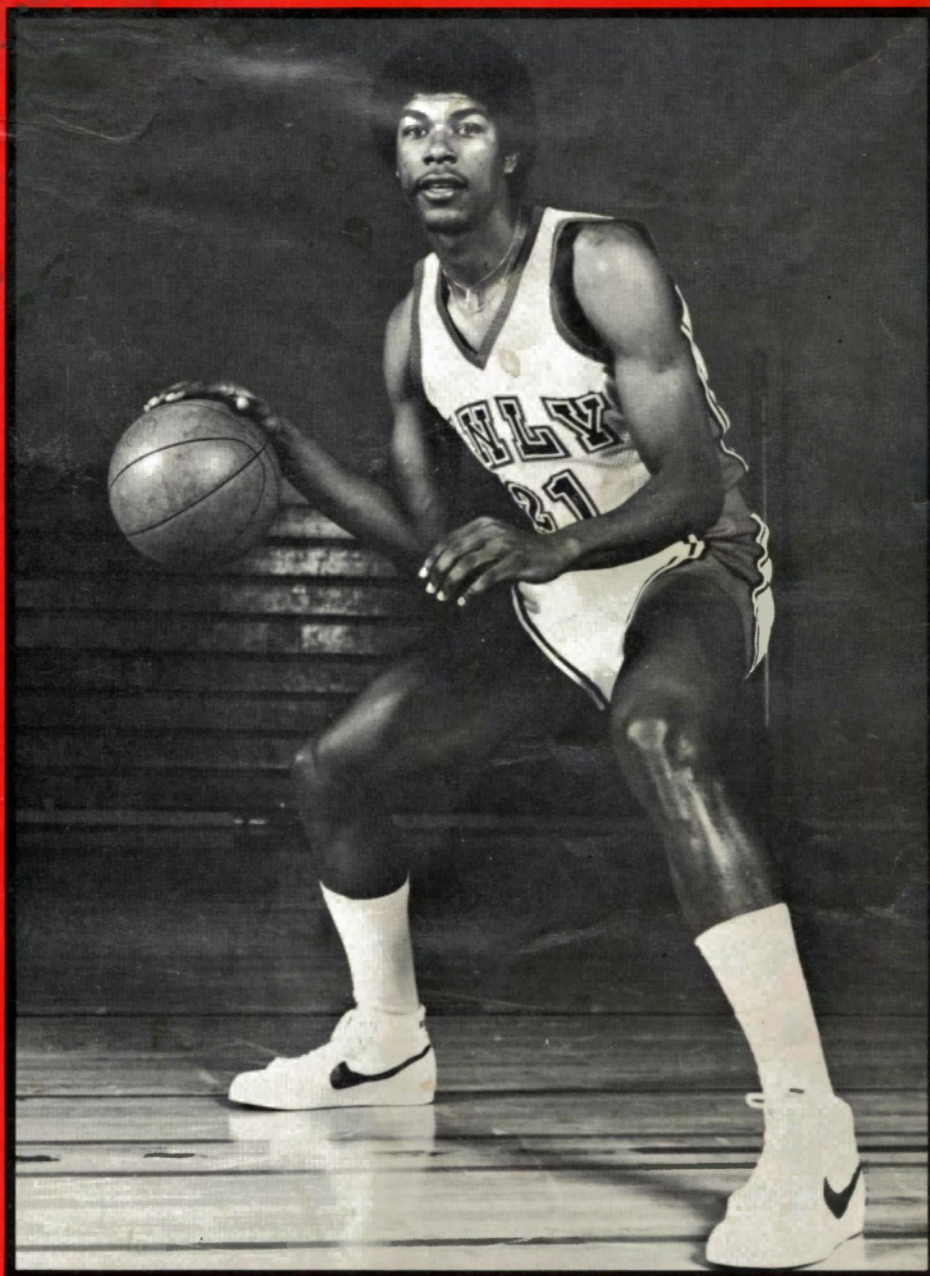

The University Rebels Club

There is not a stronger, nor more influential group supporting a college athletic program than UNLV's own University Rebels Club. Growing right along with the program over the past 20 years, the URC continues to be the driving force behind booster support for the 23-sport UNLV intercollegiate athletic program. The membership roles continue to grow daily as the group becomes one of the most prominent in the entire intercollegiate athletic world in America.

This past spring, the URC culminated its greatest fund-raising drive ever, bringing in over \$1 million for the second straight year to support the grant-in-aid program for Rebel athletics. This total once again is one of the very top in the entire nation, especially for schools without large endowment funds and lengthy lists of graduates over many decades.

The honorary list of UNLV alumni is one of the largest as the record drive indicates all the thousands of Rebel supporters there are in Las Vegas. The P & P boys who continue to ramrod the organization and the administrative duties of the URC are Davey Pearl and Dr. Wayne Pearson.

Davey, the energetic little fireball who could just about be able to talk President Carter into giving the Rebels the White House for some function, is the coordinator for booster support activities at UNLV while the reputable Dr. Pearson is UNLV's assistant athletic director for development.

The 15-member board of directors meets monthly and there are a minimum of two

general meetings of all the UNLV athletic donors per year.

And, then there are the visiting honorary alumni like Dr. Frank Sinatra who has performed and arranged the Rebel Club's "Thank You" concerts the past four years. On May 2, 1978, Sinatra's special friends who helped him honor the Rebel athletic donors were the late Totie Fields, Pat and Debby Boone, Ed McMahon, Pat Henry, Lou Rawls, Marlene Ricci, Jackie Gayle and Dave Burton. UNLV also needed to get a marching band started this year and on April 1, Wayne

Newton put on a special benefit concert for UNLV which featured Paul Anka, Glen Campbell, Nipsey Russell, Sammy Davis, Jr., Robert Goulet, Shecky Green, and Doc Severinsen. Both of these concerts were held before standing room only crowds of more than 7,500 each in the Aladdin Theatre for the Performing Arts.

The URC office is open daily at the UNLV Paul McDermott Physical Education Center or by calling 739-3614. Shirley Blackburn is again the secretary for the UNLV fund-raising office.

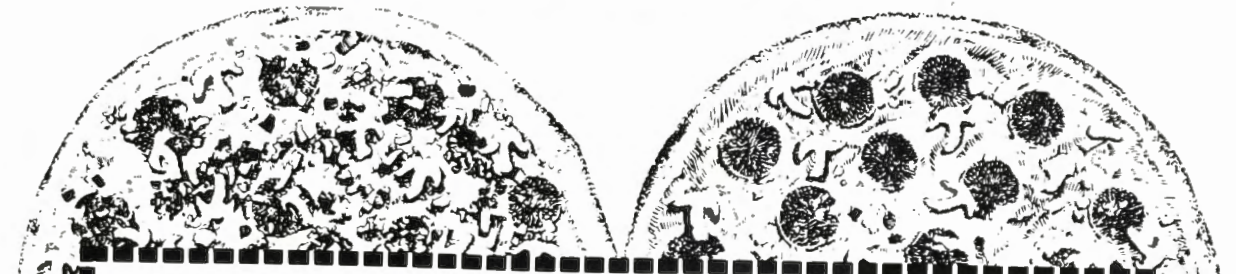

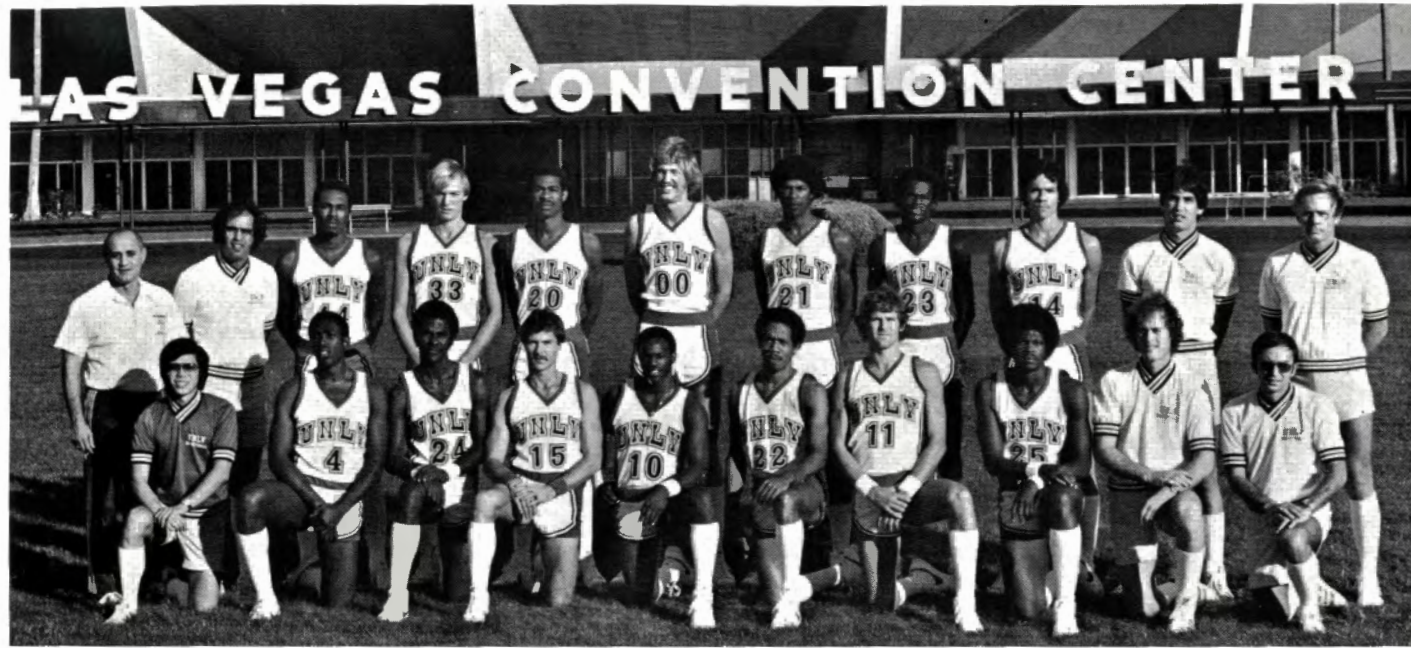

JERRY TARKANIAN HEAD COACH

UNLV Runnin' Rebel basketball has come a long, long way in a relatively short time. It wouldn't have advanced to the NCAA finals and the NCAA playoffs and been rated in the top 20 three of the past four seasons if it hadn't been for Jerry Tarkanian, the magician behind the UNLV basketball success story.

Jerry Tarkanian is, after all, the winningest active major college basketball coach in America. After 10 seasons as a major college coach, Tarkanian has coached his teams to a 244-44 record for a brilliant .847 winning percentage.

In five seasons as UNLV's head coach, Tarkanian has led the Runnin' Rebels to records of 20-6, 24-5, 29-2, 29-3, and 20-8. The goal of the players who were with Tarkanian his first four years with UNLV was to win 100 games, a goal they set for themselves as freshmen. When Eddie Owens, Glen Gon-

drezzick, Lewis Brown, Robert Smith and Sam Smith left UNLV after the 1976-77 season, their four total was 102-16, — an amazing record for an astounding group of players.

After five seasons in Las Vegas, Tarkanian's teams have compiled a record of 122-24, for a winning percentage of .836.

Last season UNLV won 15 straight games to open the season but stumbled a bit ending with "only" a 20-8 record. For Tarkanian, however, it was the most games a team he has coached ever lost and recruiting was a number 1 priority on his check list following the season.

UNLV won the Western Regional Championship during the 1976-77 season and finished with the third place trophy in the NCAA Finals in Atlanta, Georgia, in March of 1977. To get there, the Runnin' Rebels established 14 NCAA single-game, single-season and tournament records. In the playoffs, UNLV defeated the University of San Francisco, 121-95, the University of Utah, 88-83, and Idaho State, 107-90 to capture the Western Regionals.

Then UNLV lost a heartbreaker, 84-83, to the University of North Carolina, but had the pride and poise to come back and defeat the University of North Carolina-Charlotte, 106-94, for the consolation title of the 1977 NCAA Finals.

After that historic 1976-77 season, UNLV finished fourth in the final Associated Press poll, sixth in the United Press International Poll and third in the Basketball Weekly poll.

In 1975-76, UNLV won its first 23 games, ended at 29-2 with a lofty third place rating in the Associated Press poll.

Winning is a fact of life to Jerry Tarkanian, on the court and off. In 20 years of coaching in the collegiate, high school and junior college ranks, the fifth-year Runnin' Rebel coach has known nothing but unparalleled success.

In 10 seasons as a major college coach, his teams have appeared in seven NCAA post-season tournaments in addition to his being the winningest active major college coach. UNLV, all under Tarkanian, has a 7-3 record in major college NCAA playoffs.

What is equally amazing is that Tarkanian NEVER lost a home game while coaching at Long Beach State prior to coming to UNLV in 1973. His 49er teams won 65 straight home games in the campus gym and Long Beach arena, culminating with a nationally televised impressive 77-66 victory over Marquette.

At UNLV, Tark's troops have been nearly as impressive with an 84-4 record in five seasons in the Las Vegas Convention Center, including a 72-game streak at one point, which is the longest in recent NCAA vintage.

On Runnin' Rebel game nights, the otherwise stately convention hall is turned into a mass of theatrical lights explosions which quickly works the crowd into a frenzy — and that's why a prominently-placed sign welcomes visitors with "Welcome to Tark's Shark Tank."

The only two teams who dare to defeat the Runnin' Rebels in the 1973-74 season where Texas Tech, 82-76, and the University of Houston, 75-72. The Runnin' Rebels avenged the Houston loss in 1976, beating the Cougars in the opening round of the Holiday Classic, 116-92.

Last season, the University of New Mexico snapped UNLV's 72-game win skein with a 102-98 win and Portland State also trimmed the Runnin' Rebels by a 89-84 score.

Sellout crowds have been traditional at UNLV in the Tarkanian era. In the Rebels two seasons in the West Coast Athletic Conference

with Tarkanian, UNLV did not lose a home game in 14 nights. (UNLV has now withdrawn from the WACA and has membership pending final vote of the president's council to join the Western Athletic Conference.) In five seasons under Tarkanian, UNLV is 33-18 on the road.

In NCAA playoff action after the 1974-75 season, the Rebels play a sub-regional game on the campus of Arizona State, defeating San Diego State, 90-80. In the NCAA Regional tournament in Portland, Oregon, the Rebels were narrowly defeated by Arizona State, 84-81, but bounced back to capture the consolation title by defeating a favored University of Montana team, 75-67.

Following the 1975-76 campaign, the Runnin' Rebels emerged and defeated Boise State, 103-78, in a sub-regional game played on the campus of the University of Oregon in Eugene. Then the Runnin' Rebels were knocked out of the race for the national championship, losing to the University of Arizona, 114-109, in overtime, at fabled Pauley Pavilion on the UCLA campus.

Before Long Beach State, where Tarkanian's coaching reputation first drew national acclaim, he spent seven seasons in the junior college ranks at Riverside and Pasadena City Colleges. At Riverside (1962-66), he had a 131-9 overall record, which included three consecutive state championships and four league titles in five years. No other junior college coach in the history of California basketball has achieved those heights. At Pasadena (1966-68), Tarkanian was 67-4 and bagged a fourth state title while finishing in the runner-up spot his other year.

An astonishing feature of his wins is that they have been accomplished at schools which had never previously won a basketball championship. Riverside was last in its conference for two consecutive years before Tarkanian; Pasadena was last in its conference the previous year; Long Beach state had never won a championship; and UNLV had never finished higher than fourth in the WACA.

The outstanding coach started his coaching career with five years in high schools; San Joaquin Memorial, Antelope Valley and Redlands.

Regarded as one of the great recruiters in the nation, "The Pied Piper of College Basketball" landed for Long Beach State such nationally recognized superstars as Sam Robinson, George Trapp, Chuck Terry, Ed Ratleff, Leonard Gray and Roscoe Pondexter. In his first year at UNLV, Tarkanian may have recruited as well as he did during his entire tenure at Long Beach State.

As his winning tradition continues to grow, so does his reputation. Five year ago, Tarkanian brought three high school All-America performers with him. They are Eddie Owens (Houston, Texas), Lewis Brown and Jackie Robinson (both from Los Angeles).

Four years ago he recruited Robert Smith (Los Angeles), three years ago he brought Sam Smith (Las Vegas) and Reggie Theus (Inglewood, California). Two years ago, he brought in all-star junior college center Larry Moffett (Gary, Indiana) and last year Earl Evans (Port Arthur, Texas) more then proved his ability.

Jerry Tarkanian is a towel-chewing, nail-biting, hard-working Armenian who came to Las Vegas with a commitment to excellence as his inspiring philosophy. He will settle for

nothing less than excellence from his players, both on and off the court. In addition to a nationally-recognized basketball program for UNLV, Tarkanian has developed a tutorial program for his players that has paid high dividends.

UNLV attempts to emphasize equally the importance of academics and basketball to all student athletes.

Evidence of his strong belief in academics was his selection as "Professor of the Year" in 1970 by the students of Long Beach State. He was also honored as the "Father of the Year" in 1966 by Riverside County for his "guidance and care on and off the court of all the young men under his tutelage, as well as his family of four."

Tarkanian's players have gone on to play in professional basketball. They include Chuck Terry (Houston Rockets), Eric McWilliams (Houston Rockets), George Trapp (Detroit Pistons), Bob Rule (Cleveland Cavaliers), Ed Ratleff (Houston Rockets), John Q. Trapp (Los Angeles Lakers), Glenn MacDonald (Boston Celtics) and Leonard Gray (Seattle Supersonics). At UNLV, Ricky Sobers (Indiana Pacers), Glenn Gondrezick (New York Knicks), Robert Smith (Denver Nuggets), Reggie Theus (Chicago Bulls), Larry Moffett (Houston Rockets) and Ed-

die Owens (Buffalo Braves) have all played in the NBA.

In five years as the UNLV head coach, 14 players have been drafted by the NBA, including at least one each year and a NCAA and pro-basketball record of six following the 1976-77 season.

An Intense individual, Tark has coached in Ecuador for the People-to-people Sports Committee and, in April and May of 1968, he coached the Junior college Olympic Team in the Olympic Trials.

The 47-year-old coach easily won the hearts of Las Vegas fans, and the Los Angeles Times called him an "instant Las Vegas celebrity."

A native of Euclid, Ohio, Tarkanian attended Pasadena City College before graduating from Fresno State in 1955. He received his Master's degree from Redlands University in 1960.

Tarkanian and his ever-active and totally-involved wife, Lois, reside with their four children — Pamela, Jodie, Danny and George — in their sparkling Las Vegas home in the Charleston Heights area of town.

With Tarkanian's tradition and colorful image, invitations for him to speak at clinics and banquets arrive almost daily. He will average nearly one per week during the off season, sending him virtually all over the country.

Following the 1976-77 season, Tarkanian was selected by the Medalist Industry as the "College coach of the year."

This past summer, Tarkanian got his first crack as an associate director for a new movie which is entitled "The Fish that Saved Pittsburgh," and stars Julius "Dr. J" Irving.

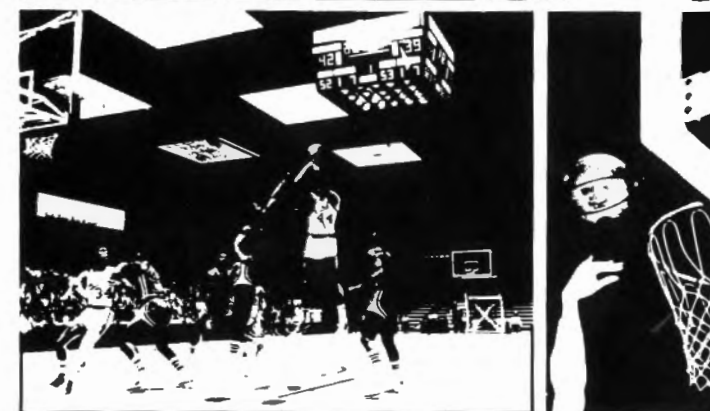

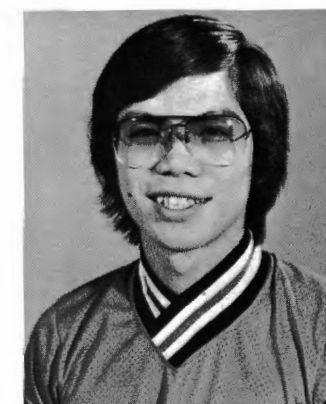

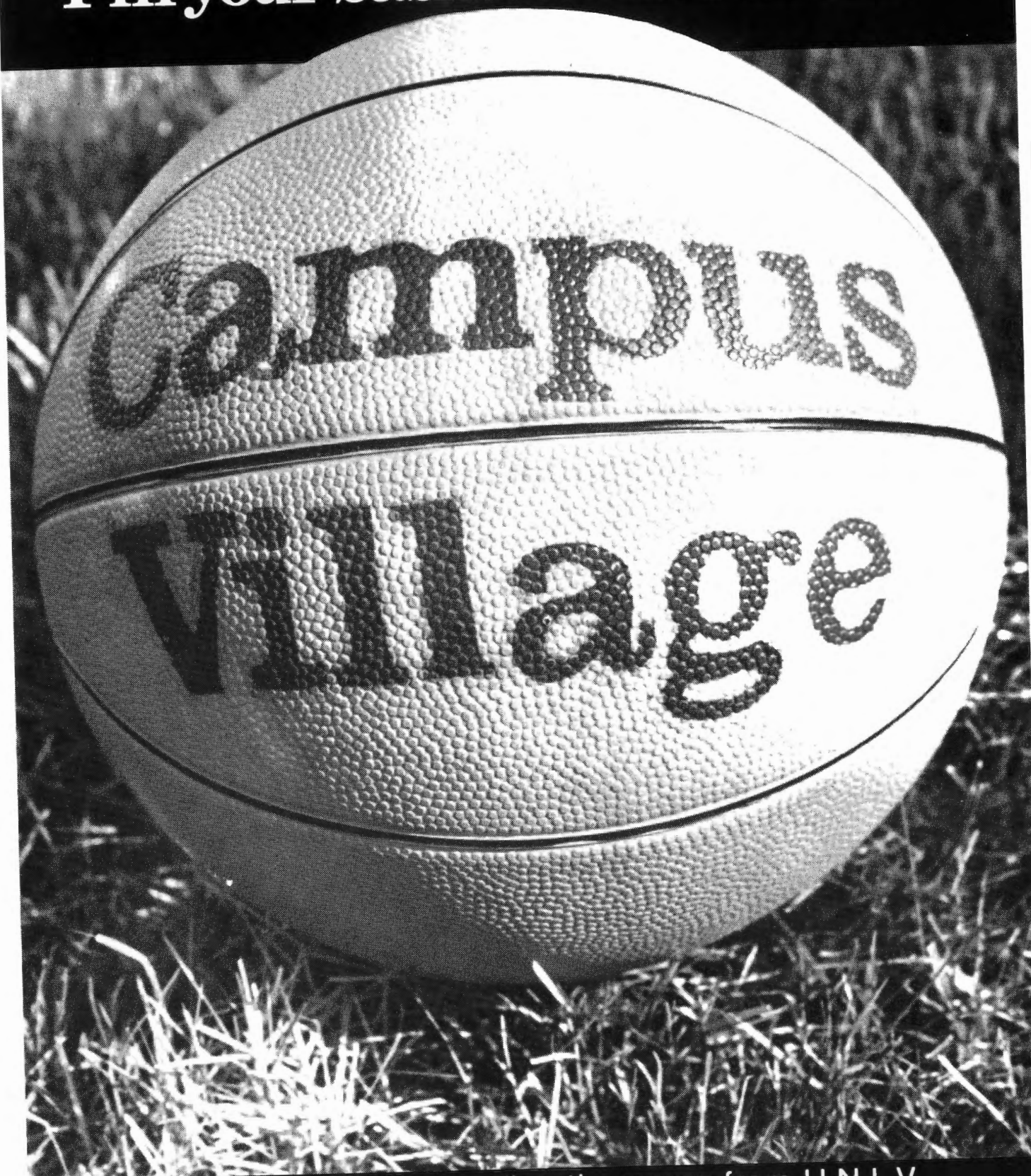

Ralph Readout returns for his fifth season as an assistant basketball coach under Jerry Tarkanian.

This exuberant coach has 14 years of head coaching experience at the prep level in Ohio, where he established winning programs at four schools.

He has an extensive background in many fields, having earned his Bachelor of Science degree in Education from Ohio University in 1953, and his Master of Arts degree in Educational Administration from Ohio State University in 1961. Readout attended Ohio University on a scholastic scholarship and graduated with honors from Ohio State's graduate school. He was a stellar basketball player during his four undergraduate years at Ohio U.

Tark's assistant is an intense and enthusiastic coach with keen insight into the learning process and psychological applications of coaching. His approach to basketball coaching is firmly based on psychological motivation and his contributions to the success of UNLV's basketball teams have been very significant.

He has a great relationship with the Runnin' Rebel players and has the innate ability to

communicate on all levels with those with whom he is associated.

He has pioneered the Big Stick technique this season at UNLV. During practice sessions and pre-practice warm-ups, he works with the UNLV big men by waving a plastic baseball bat in front of their shooting plane to help them let loose of the ball over even the tallest of opponents.

He was quite an athlete at Ohio University; he played not only basketball, but baseball as well, he was a three-year letterman starter and was elected captain of his basketball team.

He first came to UNLV in 1973 and served as an assistant football coach for one season under Ron Meyer (who is now the head coach at Southern Methodist University), working with the defensive secondary.

Developing a new coaching pattern each season he has been at UNLV, Readout has returned his hairstyle to the "crew cut" which, he says, will help bring back the "good old days when players weren't afraid of taking a charge."

Readout and his wife, Dottie, are thoroughly enamoured with the Las Vegas environment.

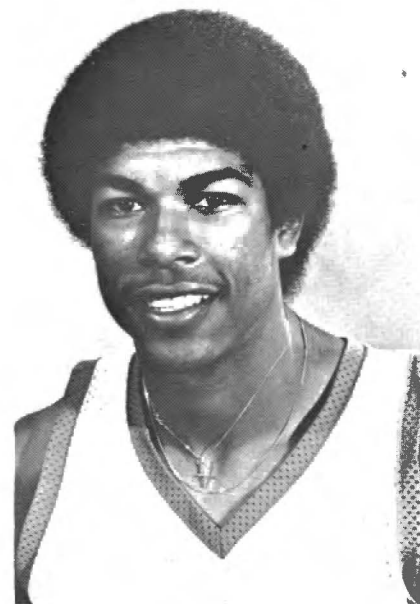

Earl "The Pearl" is back for his senior season to weave some more magic for the Runnin' Rebels. What was USC's loss two years ago when he transferred has certainly been UNLV's gain.

After sitting out a very tough year in 1976-77 when UNLV was 29-3 and advancing to the NCAA finals in Atlanta, Earl was just waiting his turn. Well, he got his first hour upon the stage last season and he made the best of his every scene.

His act was hard to top, especially when you consider that the defection of former center Larry Moffett to the NBA, forced Evans (a natural forward) to play center, a position which is not best-suited for his talents.

Rebel head coach Jerry Tarkanian has said many times that Earl Evans can be one of the finest forwards in the country and this year it appears that "The Pearl" is going to get his chance to show his real "stuff".

Playing out of position for him last year could have fooled most UNLV fans as his statistics rivaled the best centers in major college basketball. Posting up "down under," Earl still averaged 15.8 points per game, fourth highest on the team and he led the Runnin' Rebels in rebounding with a very good 10.2 boards per game.

The silky-smooth master of the dunk, fast-break and fall-away jumper virtually won several games for UNLV last season with his versatile play.

His season high was 32 points in the final UNLV home game of the season, a double-overtime thrilling victory over St. Mary's (100-98) in a game which he sent into overtime in the first place after hitting a 48-footer overhand shot at the buzzer.

In the 26 games he played for UNLV last season he scored 20 or more points on nine occasions, including one hot streak near the end of the season where he scored 23, 24, and 25 points in consecutive games, getting 11, 19, and 16 rebounds in the respective games.

Against St. Mary's, the workhouse played 47 minutes out of the possible 50, making 13 of 21 field goal attempts and six of eight free throws for his season high 32 points.

In the other Runnin' Rebel double overtime victory of 1977-78 against Tulsa, which UNLV won 104-103, "The Pearl" labored through 48 minutes, making 10 of 17 field goals, seven of 10 free throws, for 27 points and pulling down 16 rebounds. In all last season, he was in double figures in rebounding in 15 of 26 games with a season high of 19 against Portland State. His best overall night may have been against Iowa, however, in the championship game of the Rebel Roundup where his 23 points led UNLV to a 85-84 title-match victory. He made 11 of 13 from the field, one of three free throws and hauled 11 rebounds off the boards.

Earl was a prep All-America player and the 1974 Texas Prep Player-of-the-Year for Lincoln High in Port Arthur, Texas. UNLV knows how good Texas super preps can be as former UNLV All-America Eddie Owens (the all-time UNLV scoring champ) was the 1973 Texas Prep Player-of-the-Year.

Coached by James Gamble in high school, Evans played in both the Kentucky All-American and the Seamco Classic for seniors.

Evans lettered two seasons for USC, averaging 14 points per game as a sophomore before transferring to UNLV.

He can surely do all those "little" things like run, jump, shoot, hustle, and play the Big D. Those things which have made Runnin' Rebel basketball so popular across the country.

He can do them so well in fact that the UNLV basketball coaching staff has selected Earl and fellow senior Tony Smith as the UNLV co-captains for 1978-79.

Dr. Brock Dixon President



Dr. Brock Dixon, vice president for administration, has been acting president of UNLV since April when Dr. Donald Baeppler was named Chancellor of the University of Nevada System.

Dr. Dixon joined the administrative staff as dean of administration in 1971, becoming vice president in 1974. He was unanimously appointed by the Board of Regents as acting president.

He continues to keep the fast-paced style set by Chancellor Baeppler and brings to the office a comprehensive and expert knowledge of public administration.

A political scientist, Dr. Dixon specializes in local government, public law and political theory. He continues to teach courses in the political science department.

Before coming to UNLV, he was provost and dean in the College of Arts and Sciences at Pacific University in Forest Grove, Oregon, from 1968 to 1971. From 1949 to 1968 he taught and held various administrative positions at Portland State College.

His experience there included professor of political science, chairman of the political science department, assistant to the dean of faculty and dean of administration.

He received his Ph.D. in 1957 from the University of Southern California. His doctoral dissertation is titled "Governing the Suburban Fringe of Portland, Oregon."

He was awarded the MA from the University of Oregon in 1949 and the AB from Pacific College in Newberg, Oregon, in 1939.

Research projects and articles on various administrative topics have appeared in several professional journals, and he has written numerous book reviews for Western Political Quarterly.

Memberships in professional organizations include the American Political Science Association, American Society for Public Administration, University Council for Citizenship Education, Western Political Science Association and Society for College and University Planning.

Dr. Dixon was the organizer and first president of the Columbian Research Institute, a non-profit corporation specializing in research in regional political and economic problems. He has been active since 1942 in the Naval Reserve and is now a commander, USNR, retired.

From 1972 to 1977 he served on the Nevada Statewide Training Advisory Committee, and for three years was a member of the Board of Trustees for Nevada Family, a halfway house for drug addicts.

Born in Huron, S.D., the 60-year-old administrator began his career in education in 1939 as a secondary school teacher. In addition to serving in the U.S. Naval Reserve from 1944-46, he was an officer for the U.S. Internal Revenue Service from 1942-1948.

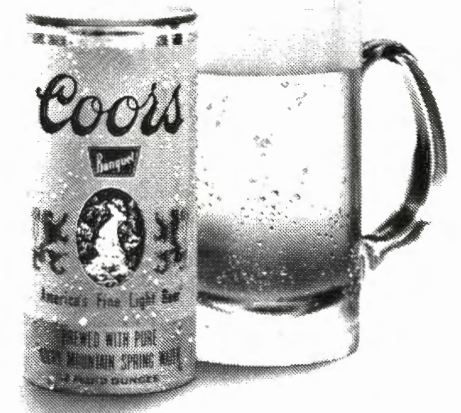

After one day's rest, the UNLV Runnin' Rebels are back at it again here on Monday night and although it may turn out to be a rather physical game, there should be no other resemblance to Monday Night Football. Well, maybe just one other. No, Howard Cosell isn't here, but former Washington Redskin All-Pro quarterback Sonny Jurgenson is the television announcer for the University of Maryland who is visiting the friendly Las Vegas Convention Center tonight.

As if Saturday night's titanic against the University of San Francisco wasn't enough to drain all of your emotions and energy, the Terrapins of colorful coach Charles "Lefty" Driesell are making their first trip to Las Vegas.

Last year, UNLV began the series with Maryland. After leading at the half and much of the second half as well, the Terps finally awoke and tore apart the Rebels by a 81-68 score in Cole Fieldhouse on the College Park campus.

As if rubbing elbows with Bill Cartwright and Wallace Bryant wasn't enough, now Earl Evans and Brett Vroman will be getting friendly with 6-9 senior Larry Gibson and superstar 6-6 sophomore Albert King, one of the most highly sought-after preps two years ago from Brooklyn, New York.

This won't be King's first visit to Las Vegas as he played here in the Basketball Congress International all-star game and came here two springs ago on a recruiting visit.

Maryland has been long on talent and is used to winning, both at home and on the road in the rugged Atlantic Coast Conference. Despite knocking off the Runnin' Rebels last year, the Terps finished a disappointing 15-13. In nine years at Maryland, Lefty Driesell has won 180 games, despite playing in one of the toughest basketball leagues in the country.

He has not had a losing season at Maryland and put together a string of five consecutive 20-plus victory seasons from 1971-72 through the 1975-76 season.

This year, the talented Terps opened their season with a resounding home triumph over Bucknell (107-97).

Last Tuesday, they played Georgetown in the Capital Centre in Washington, D.C. and while UNLV was jousting about with San Francisco on Saturday, Maryland was having a tussle with the Air Force Academy in Colorado Springs.

Maryland has three returning starters in sophomore guard Greg Manning, Gibson and King.

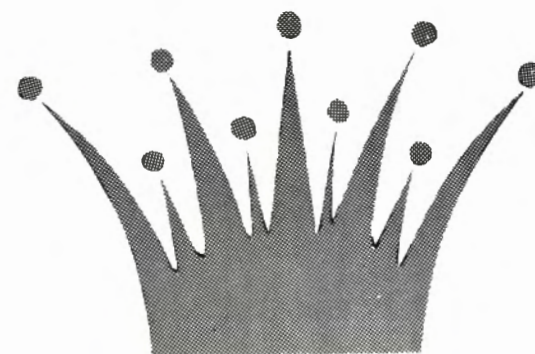
The other two probable starters for Maryland are both freshmen, 6-4 guard Reggie Jackson (no relation to the Yankee hero), and 6-8 "Buck" Williams. The two main subs for the Terps are sophomore 6-7 Ernest Graham and 6-2 freshman "Dutch" Morley.

Tonight's battle is yet another on the absolute toughest schedule the Runnin' Rebels have faced. Fortunately for the home folks, the games are in the friendly confines of the Las Vegas Convention Center, where Tark's troops have been known to pull some genuine, first-class magic out of the old basketball hat.

A Growing University

Las Vegas is known worldwide as an entertainment capital. But there is another side of the city which is gaining national recognition each year.

The University of Nevada, Las Vegas is one of the country's fastest-growing institutions of higher learning. UNLV is the hub of a new Las Vegas which adds another dimension to an already diverse and unique city.

Founded in 1957, UNLV is now the state's largest university with a total headcount enrollment of more than 9,000. Many of the university's academic programs already are well known across the nation.

To accommodate the increasing enrollment, UNLV has undertaken a massive construction program which has brought more than \$25 million worth of new buildings to the 350-acre campus in just the past five years.

These include one of the most modern teacher education facilities in the country, a major classroom and office building, a 690-seat drama theatre, a physical education complex complete with a 50-meter indoor swimming pool, new laboratories and classrooms in the life science, and a spacious 2,000-seat concert hall which serves as a cultural home for the entire community.

The next major project is a \$7 million addition to the James Dickinson Library. Ground is expected to be broken in mid-1979 with completion expected about two years later. With nearly a third of a million volumes, the current three-story library has just about reached its capacity.

A generous gift from local attorney and businessman Artemus W. Ham, Jr. has provided seed money for a new fine arts building. It is the largest single private contribution the university has ever received for a building project.

The \$10.9 million facility is included in the university's 1979-83 capitol improvement request to the legislature. The center will house teaching, research and studio facilities for the departments of theatre arts, music and art.

Because it has become such an exciting place to live and teach, the university has been able to attract some of the brightest young professors in the country.

There are more than 350 faculty on the staff now. They come from distinguished centers of learning — Berkeley, Harvard, Chicago, Princeton — and through their research and publications, they are earning a fine academic reputation for UNLV in circles of higher education.

There are currently 65 different degree programs available to students, including almost two dozen at the master's and doctoral levels.

The College of Hotel Administration, for example, ranks among the finest programs of its type in the United States, and its graduates hold top management positions in hotels, restaurants and hospitals the world over.

The university's reputation in the sciences is growing, too, as it carries out research projects in such fields as desert ecology, environmental biology and geology, taking full advantage of its unique Southwestern desert setting.

The UNLV theatre arts department continues to earn regional and national awards for its outstanding dramatic productions, and music students are now earning credits playing behind the superstars of show business on the Las Vegas Strip.

UNLV's student Jazz Ensemble recently was named the second best college jazz group in the world in competition in Switzerland. The group just returned from a critically acclaimed tour of the Orient.

The university also has a progressive teacher education program, a growing nursing department and solid preparation of students in the social sciences, the humanities, business and economics.

The future is bright for UNLV as it completes its 21st year of service to Nevada through its program of teaching, research and public service.

The WAC

The fast-growing, ever-changing Western Athletic Conference enters its 16th year of existence with a major switch in emphasis just down the road.

Beginning this season, the conference most consider "the quickest maturing intercollegiate athletic league nationally" says goodbye to charter members Arizona and Arizona State and welcomes aboard the first of three new institutions — San Diego State University.

The WAC's expansion timetable then calls for the addition of the University of Hawaii on July 1, 1979 and the University of Nevada, Las Vegas on July 1, 1980. (Pending final vote by the WAC President's Council.)

All three newcomers possess well rounded athletic programs and represent three of the fastest growing areas in the country.

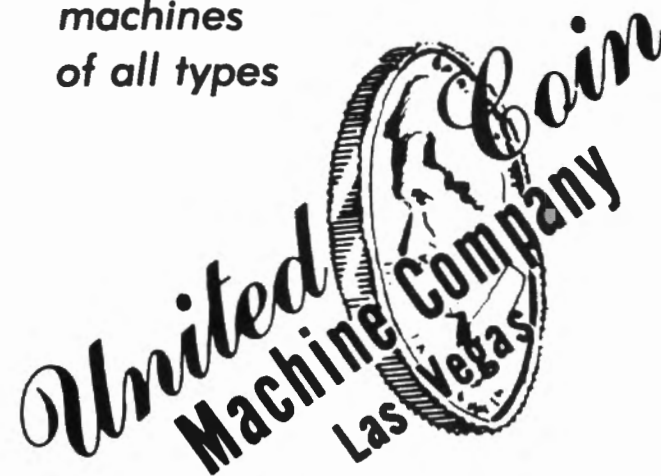
Founded on July 1, 1962, the charter members included Arizona, Arizona State, Brigham Young, New Mexico, Utah and Wyoming. In September, 1967, Colorado State and Texas-El Paso were added to make the WAC an eight team league.

Based in Denver, Colorado, the WAC is led by Commissioner Stan Bates who assumed his current position in 1971. Bates, former athletic director at Washington State University, is the conference's third commissioner.

He's assisted by Nurdy Jensen, director of information; John Adams, supervisor of football officials, and Irv Brown, supervisor of basketball officials.

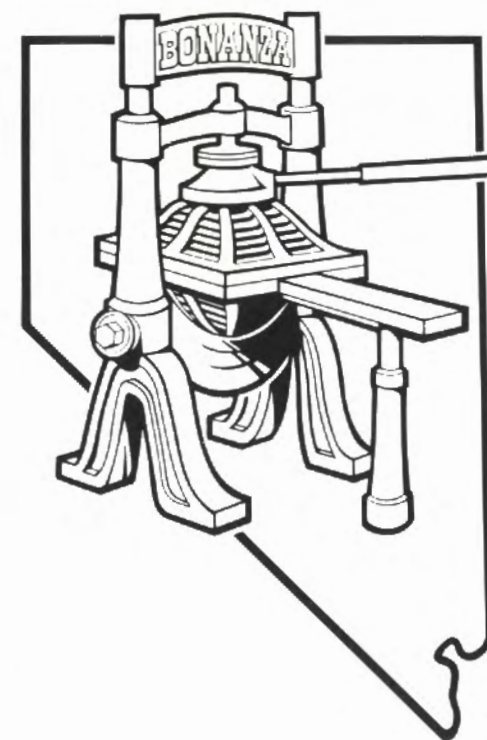

The Las Vegas Convention Center — Home of the Runnin' Rebels



Las Vegas Convention Center . . . Home of UNLV Basketball

UNLV plays all of its home games on one of the finest hardwood court arenas in the country — the 6,352 seat Las Vegas Convention Center rotunda. Capacity crowds cheer the Rebels in comfort in theater-type cushioned seats. Ample parking is available at the conveniently located facility, one mile east of the fabled Las Vegas "Strip."

Rather homey with its limited seating capacity, UNLV enjoys playing in its home facility and established an all-time record by winning 72 straight games before being defeated by the University

of New Mexico on Jan. 7, 1978 by a 102-98 score. Under head coach Jerry Tarkanian, the Runnin' Rebels have raced up and down the court for an impressive 84-4 record in the Convention Center the past five seasons against regular NCAA competition. This year, UNLV will play 18 games in the boisterous facility.

The sign hanging ominously over the rotunda floor reads, "Welcome to Tark's Shark Tank." It would more appropriately read, "Enter at your own risk." After the swirling of the multi-colored spotlights in the darkened arena to herald the introduction of the local favorites, the fireworks really begin. It is the Convention Center where the Runnin' Rebels earned their expanded nickname. During the 1974-75, 1975-76, and 1976-77 seasons, the Runnin' Rebels, Gunnin' Rebels did not lose a home game. In 1976-77, UNLV played 19 home games, scoring 2,109 points for an average of 111.0 per game. The fast-moving fleet-footed eagles of the hardwood soared to 100 or more points in 16 of those 19 games and in a pre-season exhibition game against the National Team of the Republic of China, UNLV actually pumped in 174 points in a 40-minute game.

Like its' renown counterparts on the "Strip", the Convention Center "Showroom" has been virtually SOLD OUT for the past five years, with only very limited seating available for but a few games.

Producing the elaborate light shows during pre-game ceremonies again this season is long-time Rebel supporter, Art Rader.

Some visiting coaches have vowed to never again return to the site of their most humiliating defeat. Four opponents have actually left Las Vegas winners over the past five years.

All visitors have left "Tark's Shark Tank" knowing they have just experienced something that will remain with them the rest of their lives.

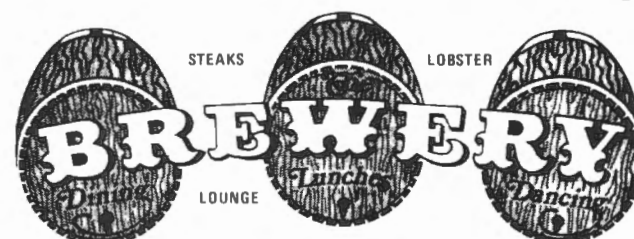

Since leaving Utah, he has also been involved with many youth groups, including the Boy Scouts of America and coaching in the Little League baseball program.

At UNLV, he has organized a very solid ticket office, working very closely with students of the university as well as the university business office.

He and his wife Susan have four children, three boys and one girl.
